

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Bread of Life

The hymn writer D.T. Niles once wrote that “Christianity is one beggar telling another beggar where he found bread.” Sharing who we are in life as a whole reflects this spirit. It is not that we are better than those around us or have more insight. It is the sharing of something we have learned or experienced, something that keeps us going. We often tell others what feeds us (our minds and spirits), nourishes us and gives us strength and joy. We share what we are and have.

Giving and receiving is what human life is all about. You cannot be human alone. We tell children to share their toys. As we become adults, shared needs often find solutions we cannot find alone. All of this recalls the apostles’ willingness to give up their regular jobs and routines and become part of something greater.

Jesus shares His Body and Blood with us at each and every Mass. The Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus is placed before us so that we might let Him enter our lives, joys and sorrows. Jesus taught us how sharing is being fully alive, giving of ourselves and receiving from others. Whether we are wealthy or poor, we have something to give and something eternal to gain.

In the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, what transpired on Calvary’s cross is a reality once again in an unbloody manner. Jesus Christ is the Holy Priest. Jesus Christ is the Victim. At holy Mass, we are the ones who, in the most intimate union with Jesus Christ, receive the Sacrifice of Sacrifices, the Eucharist.

PREPARATIONS FOR THE SACRAMENTS

Breaking News from the Bishops of Connecticut

As the situation surrounding the pandemic improves in our State, the Bishops of Connecticut are ending the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays. Furthermore, in response to CDC guidelines, vaccinated residents of Connecticut are no longer required to wear masks indoors after May 19, 2021.

- For those who are fully vaccinated, you are no longer required to wear a mask to attend Mass or any other liturgical or social function held on parish property.
- In an abundance of safety, those who are fully vaccinated are free and welcome to continue to wear masks if you choose to do so.
- All those who are not fully vaccinated must continue to wear masks when attending Mass or any other liturgical or social function held on parish property.

This obligation, borne from our commitment to protect human life, transcends the mandate of the state. It flows from our very belief in the Lord of life, who commands us to protect, defend and respect all human life, from natural conception to natural death.



SPONSOR CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

Our parish receives a number of requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor. Being a Godparent or a Sponsor is not just a family or social relationship, as important as these may be. It is a profound spiritual responsibility which entails witness and commitment and there are several requirements:

The Godparent/Sponsor is to be at least sixteen years old.

He/she is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation.

If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.

For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

You are a currently registered member of the parish.

You worship here regularly.

You are requesting the Sponsor Certificate yourself; please do not ask a parent, spouse or another person to do this for you.

No Sponsor Certificates will be signed or issued before or after weekend Masses.




