

## A MESSAGE FROM DEACON BRAD SMYTHE

"By the guidance of a star"

God led the Magi by the guidance of a star. They followed the star to Jerusalem and lost sight of it. Because of that, they assumed that the newborn King would be found in the royal palace. They were likely amazed that He was not there and that it had been prophesied that He would be born in Bethlehem. King Herod deceived them into thinking that he also wanted to do the new King homage once He was found.

As they set off for Bethlehem, the star reappeared and led them directly to Jesus, Mary and Joseph. Once they arrived, they had no doubt that the baby in His mother's arms was the Messiah. They prostrated before Him and presented their gifts. Finally, they obeyed God's warning in a dream to not return to Herod. This would have certainly given the Holy Family more time to escape to Egypt.

In our own lives, our own pilgrimage toward God and Eternity, He is leading each of us. Our ability to recognize where He wants us to go is dependent upon our hearts and minds being open to His will, along with a willingness to seek Him out. To the extent that we are not open to His will and may not be actively working to grow closer to Him, we can lose sight of the "star" that our souls received at baptism through the Holy Spirit.

On this day, may we take these words of St. Gregory Nazianzen to heart: "Run after the star, and bring gifts with the Magi, gold and frankincense and myrrh, as to a king and a God and one dead for your sake. With the shepherds give glory, with the angels sing hymns, with the archangels dance... For I am persuaded that they rejoice and celebrate with us today."

## SPONSOR CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

Our parish receives a number of requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor. Being a Godparent or a Sponsor is not just a family or social relationship, as important as these may be. It is a profound spiritual responsibility which entails witness and commitment and there are several requirements:

The Godparent/Sponsor is to be at least sixteen years old.

He/she is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation.

If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.

## For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

You are a currently registered member of the parish. You worship here regularly.

You are requesting the Sponsor Certificate yourself; please do not ask a parent, spouse or another person to do this for you.




#### **IRAs**
