

DIRECTOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**


**Winter Greetings from the
Religious Education Office!**

I hope you and your family are remaining warm and healthy this season.

The Religious Education program intends to continue holding in-person instruction so long as Shelton schools continue to have classes and sports in-person. Parents are, of course, encouraged to use their best judgement with regard to sending their children to class or keeping them home, and we understand and support their decisions. During this surge of the Omicron Covid variant, we know that families will make different choices regarding their participation in classroom learning, and we respect the decisions our families make.

That said, there is one decision I hope I can make for all our students: if a child has symptoms, please keep that child home, especially if that child did not go to school that day. In this way we hope to limit everyone's potential exposure to Covid. Thank you for your cooperation.

As the cold weather sets in, our thoughts often turn to those who go without adequate food, shelter, and clothing. The people of St. Joseph Parish have always responded generously to various drives and calls for support that have been made in our community. SPONSOR CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

Our parish receives a number of requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor. Being a Godparent or a Sponsor is not just a family or social relationship, as important as these may be. It is a profound spiritual responsibility which entails witness and commitment and there are several requirements:

The Godparent/Sponsor is to be at least sixteen years old.

He/she is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation.

If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.

For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

You are a currently registered member of the parish.

You worship here regularly.

You are requesting the Sponsor Certificate yourself; please do not ask a parent, spouse or another person to do this for you.

The sessions include prayer, teachings on different topics, along with time for questions and answers. There are no textbooks and no test!






