

From the Pastor's Desk

"Do Whatever My Son Tells You to Do" By Rev. M. Dogali

There is a very beautiful passage in the Book of Revelation, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." It is into this that our Lord offers us the opportunity to be one with Him.

In the Gospel, we see that the Blessed Mother was concerned that we should be one with her Son. "Do whatever my Son tells you to do." If we have clothed the stranger, fed the hungry, if we have done all of these good things to people because we are all strays, this is not enough. We are all hungry. We all have needs. We will find ultimate happiness.

What is our greatest need? Our need for love. Each one of us, whoever we may be, married, single, priest, lay person, religious, we all need above all love, to feel that we are loved, to believe that we are loved for ourselves, whatever we have done.

To me it seems the worst sins are perhaps less in what we do than in what we fail to do, the opportunity given to us; the person sitting next to us, the people next door, those with whom we work, those who may be lonely, those who are suffering, that we do not reach out to help. That, perhaps, is even worse than things that we might do to them that would be reprehensible.

Every day I must remind myself and everyone else of the infinite mercy of Jesus who never, never gives up on us. That sudden and awesome mercy can come in the flash of a moment, especially at the last instant of our lives, if only we will do what her Son commands.



SPONSOR CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

Our parish receives a number of requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor. Being a Godparent or a Sponsor is not just a family or social relationship, as important as these may be. It is a profound spiritual responsibility which entails witness and commitment and there are several requirements:

The Godparent/Sponsor is to be at least sixteen years old.

He/she is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation.

If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.

For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

You are a currently registered member of the parish. You worship here regularly.

You are requesting the Sponsor Certificate yourself; please do not ask a parent, spouse or another person to do this for you.


