A GOSPEL REFLECTION... We tend to believe that unless everyone believes the same thing, and assents to the same opinions, unity is not possible. Jesus, in today's Gospel, expresses a tenderness that the disciples actually can witness. This tenderness and love are reflected in his desire for unity. The success of Jesus' mission rises or falls with whether this unity is achieved. It is a unity that is achieved around a person and not particulars.

Our church is extremely divided. These divisions center on theologies, philosophies, structures, and styles. We allow these, valid as many can be, to put us at odds with each other. They cause us to lash out at other members of the Body of Christ. Staunchly clinging to particular agendas and ideologies while waving the "we're right, you're wrong" banner does little to advance the mission of Christ.

"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." This is the principle that draws the Body of Christ together. We give too much power to our preferences. If we can work at loving each other as members of Christ's Body despite the differences that divide us, maybe we'll be more convincing to those who do not believe.

We cannot substitute Jesus' passion with our own. We are one.

## Forty Hours Devotion

In this Year of the Eucharist, Bishop Byrne has scheduled seven 40 Hours' Devotions throughout the diocese. The next is June 2-5 at Our Lady of the Valley in Easthampton. It begins with Mass at noon. The church remains open for the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Rosary, and continuous hours of personal adoration. The closing is on Pentecost with 4 PM Solemn Vespers. Future dates are in Stockbridge, Chicopee, and Ware.

Forty Hours' Devotion, in Italian *Quarant'ore*, or *Quarantore*, is a Catholic exercise of devotion in which continuous prayer is made for forty hours before the Blessed Sacrament in exposition. The 40 Hours' time is patterned on the 40 hours that Christ's body traditionally rested in the tomb.

### **JUNE 12, ST. GASPAR BERTONI DAY**

This year the saint's feast falls on a Sunday. We look forward to observing it as the founder's feast of the Stigmatine priests who serve our parish, and as the patronal feast of our Knights of Columbus Council #5037.
