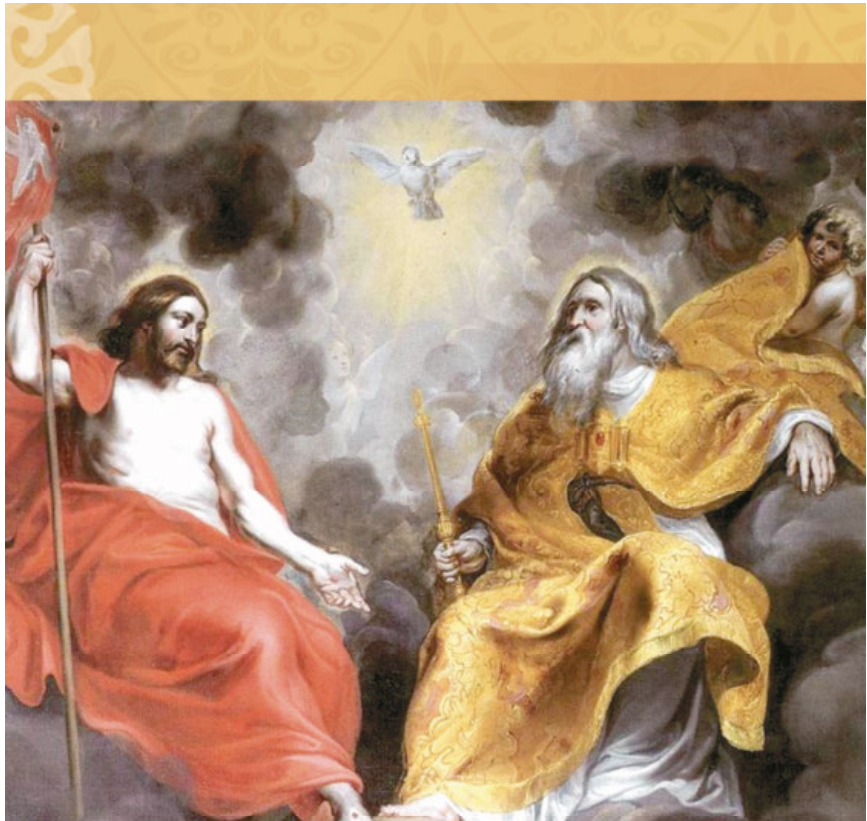

A GOSPEL REFLECTION . . . In creative celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, pray a rosary with creation. Ask for wisdom and understanding. *"You are three in one, God above all gods. You are love. You are beauty. You are gentleness. You are joy. You are hope and happiness."* St. Francis
