A GOSPEL REFLECTION . . . And to another he said, “FOLLOW ME.” Jesus makes it clear that once we say yes to his invitation, we must stay focused and forge ahead. We cannot worry about unfinished business. There are some tasks, and discipleship is one, that require our full devotion.

Given the choice between a “master” that promises worldly success, wealth, status, privilege, and security versus a “master” that asks for self-sacrifice, hardship, suffering, ridicule, and death, to whom do we go? While the promise of immediate pleasure is enticing, there is always a catch. For all that secular masters can promise, they keep us slaves to excessive worry. Only one master really promises life: Jesus Christ. Hearing his call, we either trust him or we don’t.

There is no need to keep looking behind. Sins are forgiven and regrets serve no purpose. God is not there. He’s moved beyond all that stuff. God is in the today and the tomorrow and what he can do with our daily affirmation to follow Him. All we need to do is be obedient.
