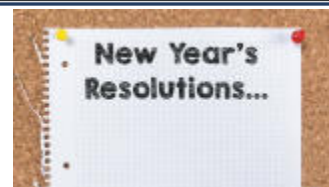

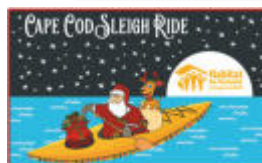
**A MESSAGE ABOUT CAPE COD HOSPITAL**
