Pope Francis on the Synod:

"I ... encourage you to take this synodal process seriously and to tell you that the Holy Spirit needs you, ... Listen to him. Listen to each other; do not leave anyone out."

The two-year synodal process involves "a dynamism of mutual listening, conducted at all levels of the church, involving the whole people of God," "Synodality expresses the nature of the church, its form, its style, its mission, ... The Greek word synod means 'walking together.'"

"If the parish is the house of all in the neighborhood, not an exclusive club, I recommend that you leave the doors and windows open; do not limit yourselves to those who frequent [the parish] or think like you, ... Let everyone enter.... Let their questions be your questions; allow yourselves to walk together. The Spirit will lead you. Do not be afraid to enter into dialogue; it is the dialogue of salvation." DYECHE CARING CARDS

The program began more than two decades ago by the Dennis-Yarmouth Ecumenical Council for the Prevention of Homelessness (DYECH) and was later adopted by the Barnstable Interfaith Council (BIC) has been a resounding success. Known as Cape Cod Caring Cards, the program is simple: DYECHE and BIC purchase gift cards in bulk from businesses. In return the two nonprofits receive a percentage on every purchase. The gift cards are sold to you at face value. The proceeds go directly to Housing Assistance Corporation to oversee Project Prevention which provides financial assistance to help residents on Cape Cod struggling with their bills stay in their homes.

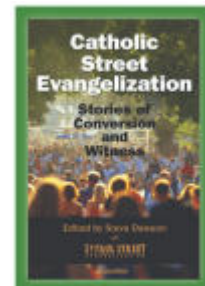
