

Dear Parishioners,

We have been successful in using ZOOM for lively group discussions and videos sharing and we will continue using ZOOM this year along with face-to-face meetings for each course in a hybrid environment. Over sixty people actively participated in last year's program and we are hoping others will join us in these courses as we come together to know God better for ourselves and to serve Him and others. Participants will meet every week to view an engaging video presentation followed by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship. ### **PROPHETS: *Messengers of God's Mercy*** **Monday Mornings at 9:30 at St. George's Hall**

If we consider that God is the Divine Bridegroom and the Church is his Bride, then the prophets can be seen as "spiritual marriage counselors." They afflict the comfortable and comfort the afflicted, calling us to return to our covenant relationship with God. They urge us to repentance, warn us of the dangers of sin, and announce the blessings of faithfulness. Their prophetic words speak to us even today, as they draw us closer to our heavenly Bridegroom.

Participants will begin a ten-weeks Bible study Prophets: Messengers of God's Mercy on **September 13, Monday at 9:30 AM at St. George Hall.**

### **HEBREWS: *The New and Eternal Covenant***

**Tuesdays Mornings at 9:30 at St. George's Hall or Tuesdays Evenings at 6:30 at St. Margaret's Parish Center**

In this study, Catholics will be able to see, appreciate, and take hold of the riches God has given them in the New Covenant. Highlighting the critical distinctions between the Old and New Covenants, Hebrews will help Catholics get to know the generosity of the Father's heart in a deeper way than ever before. Sts. George and Margaret's will begin two separate classes on Hebrews on **September 14 at 9:30 AM and 6:30 PM.**

Participants will meet every week to view an engaging video presentation by Dr. Andrew Swafford and Jeff Cavins, followed by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship.

### **The Gospel of Matthew: *The King and His Kingdom*** **Wednesday Mornings at 9:30 AM at St. George's Hall**

The book of Matthew brings the history of Christ to life. We see Jesus as the awaited Messiah who fulfills the promises and prophecies of the Old Testament, establishes the New Law, and inaugurates the kingdom of heaven. Matthew: The King and His Kingdom, a twenty-four-part Bible study, explores how Jesus is challenging and empowering us to a new level of holiness and shows how we must be thoroughly immersed in the kingdom of heaven on earth, the Church, to live it.

Participants will begin on **September 15** and meet every week to view an engaging video presentation followed by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship.

### **The BIBLE Timeline: *The Story of Salvation*** **Wednesday Evenings at 6:30 at St. Margaret's Parish Center**

Reading the Bible should bring us closer to Christ, but understanding it is often difficult. The good news is that you can understand the Bible, and *The Bible Timeline*, a twenty-four-part Bible study, makes it easy. The Bible Timeline should be considered as your first course in this Great Adventure of Bible Study.

Presenter Jeff Cavins shows you how fourteen of the Bible's narrative books tell the biblical story from beginning to end and gives you the keys to understanding the amazing story woven throughout Scripture. In this revolutionary approach to Bible study, *The Bible Timeline* divides the Bible into twelve color-coded time periods that make it easier to follow its narrative thread. Using a unique color-coded chart, you will learn the major people, places, and events of the Bible and discover how they all come together to reveal the remarkable story of our faith.

Participants will begin on **September 15, at 6:30 PM.** meet every week to view an engaging video presentation followed by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship.

### **Psalms: *The School of Prayer*** **Thursday Evenings at St. George's Hall**

At the heart of the Bible are the Psalms, prayers from God that help us learn to pray. The Holy Spirit inspired them. Israel sang them. Christ himself prayed them, as did our Blessed Mother. These sacred hymns become our heartfelt response to God's loving and wondrous deeds for us. Their words captivate the imagination and draw us into a deeply personal encounter with God.

Participants will begin the eleven-week Bible study on *Psalms: The School of Prayer* on **Thursday, September, 16, from 6:30-8:30 PM.**

## Volunteers Needed



For many years, St. George parishioners have participated in the Annual HomeFront Project, helping to spruce up the homes of local residents who have been unable to complete projects due to financial, physical, or other challenging circumstances. HomeFront, along with local volunteers, provides services that enable homeowners to both maintain and stay living in the homes they love.

This year HomeFront has selected a Guilford residence. The home is a single-family, two-story home that is in need of exterior painting. Our young adult group, which would normally be going to Appalachia, has stepped up to paint the interior of the home. However, there is significant additional prep work to be done before the exterior painting can be applied. We will need a large group of volunteers to tackle this project. St. George parishioners have always stepped up, and so we are asking again for volunteers to help with this project. The planned date for this project would be **Saturday, Sept. 11 with a rain date of Sept. 25.**

Additionally, HomeFront limits the height to which a volunteer may climb. Due to the height of this home, all volunteers will be working on the first level of the home. We are looking for a professional painting company that would be willing to tackle the second floor and above. All paint and painting supplies will be provided. The second floor of the home is shingled and in very good condition. If you are a professional painter and would be willing to give of your time and talents for this worthy cause, we would love for you to join us. Your company will not be bound by any time constraints of working solely on a Saturday. You may work on the home whenever you wish.

### Consecration to Mary begins September 4th






