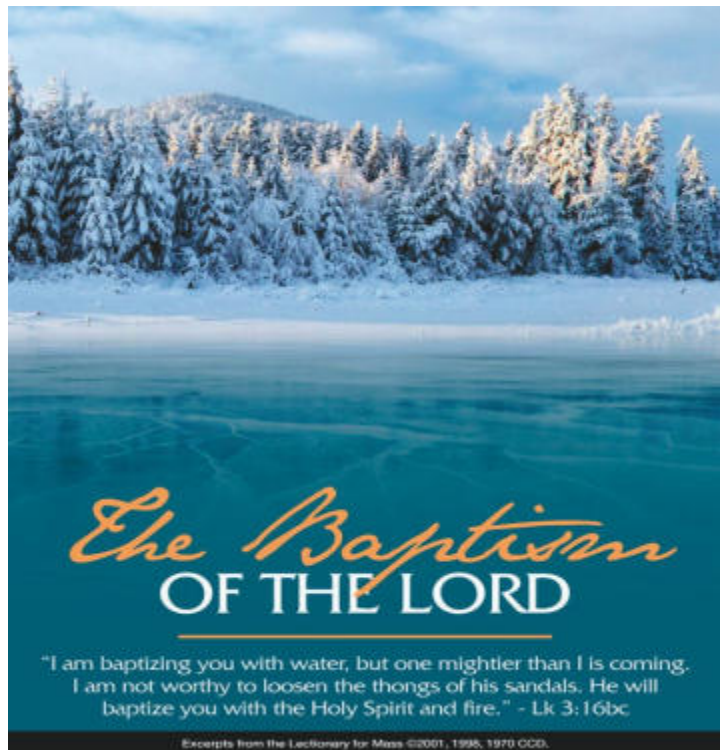

From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Parishioners,

Another New Year has begun. Unfortunately, it isn't beginning well in regard to Covid positivity rates. This horrible virus is going to continue to challenge us to be diligent, patient, and careful in how we go about our daily lives. The same applies to our coming to Mass each week. As I mentioned last weekend, I strongly encourage every one of us to wear a mask while in church and our other parish buildings. I know, I know, we're all tired of it, but with the positivity rate being so high, I think that we can all endure this inconvenience for the short amount of time that we are in church. I am very appreciative of everyone's cooperation with this request.

If you have visited another parish, you may have noticed that they may have put Holy Water in the fonts, have the gifts of bread and wine brought up during mass, and have youth altar servers. Recently, the priests received a memo from Archbishop Blair regarding these items. In his memo, Archbishop said that having Holy Water in the fonts and the bringing up of the gifts of bread and wine is now left to the pastor's discretion. As much as I would like to bring these practices back, I don't think that now is the right time to bring them back. Once Covid positivity rates get down below 10 percent, I think that we can all feel more comfortable in re-introducing these practices. Regarding our youth Altar Servers, we were instructed that only fully vaccinated individuals are allowed to serve at this time. We are reaching out to our Altar Servers to find out who would like to begin serving again.

I would like to say how much I enjoyed my first Christmas in Guilford and at St. George Parish. I say "Guilford" as well as "St. George" because, as you all know, the area around the Green plays such an important part in the experience of Christmas here in Guilford. Every evening, I've enjoyed looking at the buildings surrounding the Green, and on the other streets near the Green, displaying the white candles in their windows; it really is quite a beautiful sight. I was so pleased with our celebration of Christmas; the church decorations and the music were so wonderful and uplifting. I'm very grateful to our decorating/flower committee and musicians for the outstanding effort that they made to make our celebration so beautiful and meaningful.

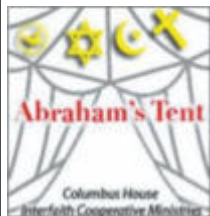

Suggested items are as follows:

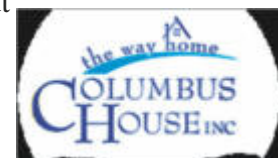
- All clothing items must be NEW, not used in any way.
