NEW ALTAR SERVER TRAINING

Training for new altar servers will take place on **Saturday, June 21st at 11:00 AM**. The session will last one hour. Parents of those who have already expressed interest in becoming servers have received an email about this training. Others who are interested can attend by contacting Joanne DiMeglio (jdimeglio@borromeo.org) If you cannot attend the session, but would like to become a server, please let her know. Any child who has received First Communion is eligible to become an altar server.

Our altar servers help out at the Saturday 5:00 PM Mass, and the 8:30 and 10:00 AM Masses on Sunday (Members of Youth Ministry serve as liturgical ministers at the 11:30 AM Mass.) We ask parents of our servers to let us know which Mass or Masses they prefer to serve. For the most part we are able to accommodate those requests.

Becoming an altar server enables young people to become more aware of the parts of the Mass, as well as the other liturgical ministers. By the time they enter high school, some of our servers transition to becoming lectors or Eucharistic ministers.

We look forward to welcoming new altar servers who will join the great group already serving.

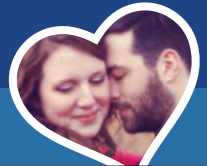
