

## *Where Do You Find Rest?*



Growing up in the Midwest I always looked forward to the summertime for outdoor fun and a break from the normal routine. As much as the season of sun is enjoyed in the heartland, it doesn't compare to how New Englanders cherish this time of year. You all take your summers seriously! Taking a break in the midst of the beauty of nature is deeply rooted in New England culture and that's a wonderful thing. In our fast-paced, open 24- hours - a -day society where work and staying busy is often valued more than relaxation and rejuvenation, it is a blessing to know the importance of rest. Jesus brings this home in today's gospel reading when He invites His apostles to *"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while."*

Last Sunday we heard how Jesus sent the twelve out two by two to do the hard work of preaching the gospel. Now that they've come back from their respective journeys, He is calling them to rest. Christ recognizes the need for physical and emotional rest, but He is also inviting them to a deeper quiet - a healing stillness in their hearts that they will find only with Him. Just as Jesus' miraculous healings of people's physical ailments were always a sign of the more profound mending of their souls, so too is His invitation to us to rest. The truth is that we can take time off in leisure or go on vacation to the most tranquil settings and still not be at peace. As St. Augustine said, *"You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you."* If we are not taking time to regularly rest in God, then our time off or away will not renew us on the deepest level and fill us with the peace of Christ, Himself.

How do we experience this kind of spiritual rest? One way is to invite God into our moments of leisure. When we are enjoying a quiet place or a relaxing activity, we can ask God to make us more aware of His presence with us and to welcome Him into that moment. He can transform that human activity into a time of Sabbath rest. To go deeper into our rest with Jesus we really need to take time on a regular basis to be with Him in personal prayer. This could be by taking ten minutes at the end of day silently reflecting on the events and interactions we had and ask God to show us how He has been with us through it all. We can also quietly read and pray through a short reading from the Bible, like today's gospel, and ask Jesus to speak to us through it. Spending time with Jesus in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a perfect way to "come away and rest a while" with Him. The Lord knows that life is exhausting and wants to refresh us with His presence and peace. This summer, let's make sure to take some of that time off and turn it into time away with Jesus!


