
"For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord." - Lk 2:11

CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

Christmas time is a time of very heavy travel. Many people fly or drive to their destination to be with family. There is something special about gathering with family members to celebrate this beautiful Feast. The Church continues the theme of family with the celebration of the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph on this Sunday, December 26th. Family is an important part of all of our lives.

The Second Scripture Reading this Sunday from the Letter to the Colossians contains some advice that would certainly strengthen all of our families. Paul advises that as God's chosen ones we have "heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another." Those are certainly powerful gifts to build up one's family!

The Church sees family life as a very special part of society. The Catholic Catechism states: "The family is the original cell of social life. It is the natural society in which husband and wife are called to give themselves in love and in the gift of life." The Catechism further states: "The family is the community in which from childhood, one can learn moral values, begin to honor God, and make good use of freedom. Family life is an initiation into society."

As we hear this Sunday's Gospel of Luke, the Holy Family also traveled to Jerusalem for the celebration of Passover. Their experience of family life here and in other Gospel passages reminds us that we look to the Holy Family for inspiration in our own family life.

Let us pray during this Christmas Season in thanksgiving for the gift of family. Let us consciously make an effort to strengthen our families with the gifts that St. Paul suggested. May our families be blessed in every way in this special season and throughout the New Year.



Save the date of Thursday, December 30, for an ice skating outing! More details will be posted on our website.




