


Televised Weekend Mass

PASTORAL REFLECTION

(From the Prodigal Son story, Luke 15: 11-32)

Coming Home. No longer the swine food in a foreign land. But to the feast of Home where our Father is ready to run to us, bare -footed with open arms.

But unlike this man, you and I do not make the long and fearful journey alone. Because unlike the cold and mean older brother of the parable, our Older Brother came to our exile to find us. He came to embrace us with arms fixed open on the Cross. Our older brother clothes us with Himself at our baptism. Everything He shares with His Father, He now shares with us by giving his Blood as the sign of Eternal covenant like a ring on a finger. He feeds us with His Body on the journey Home.

So yes, we do not make the journey alone, but at least we must let our Older Brother find us in the confessionals and every Sunday by coming to Mass. There, we meet our Brother and our Home away from Home.

So, come and let Christ find you and take you Home. It's time.

Pope Francis is inviting you into a conversation!

It's officially called, "The Synod on Synodality", which, as you have already learned, has begun!

What does that mean?! It's simply a "walking on the same road, together", as Pope Francis describes, just like Jesus did – encountering, listening and discerning with all whom one meets". This road will lead us to become a better listening Church, a Church that listens to the Holy Spirit and to one another –

laity, priests, bishops – as it discerns the will of God for the life and mission of the Church.

The process is three-fold: 1. Locally, bringing parishioners together to discuss questions on how to become a better listening Church. 2. Summaries are sent to the Archdiocese and on to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). 3. The summaries of each nation will be forwarded to the Vatican who will assemble the Synod of Bishops in October, 2023.

Next week, we will begin the conversation, here at St. Michael, before/after Mass in the parish hall. See the schedule below. To prepare for the conversation, spend some time in prayer with the Holy Spirit and reflect on these questions:

- 1. Thinking about our parish, archdiocese and the church, who has a voice, and who should have a voice?
- 2. Are you able to dialogue openly and freely with anyone in the church on important matters? What has helped this process? What prevents this process?
- 3. Do you feel you have the opportunity and feel equipped to fulfill God's mission of making disciples for Jesus through our parish or the greater Catholic Church?
- 4. Do you feel the decision-making process within your local parish community could be improved? Is prayerful discernment a part of the process?
