



Luke 24:34; cf. Revelation 1:6




Thank you for joining us today to share this beautiful day that the Lord has made. We rejoice as we celebrate the Risen Lord who makes all things new for us.

That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You." (Diary 327) "The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the cross. ... Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter. for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him." (Diary 299)

PASTORAL REFLECTION

The Empty Tomb.

Oh No, someone stole His dead body.

All three disciples had heard Jesus predicting about His Resurrection on the third day, the Sunday after the Good Friday. But what they just had gone through was so real and dark, they didn't have the luxury of thinking about those heavenly things. So, that was their conclusion.

We all have a huge empty tomb in our hearts and souls. All our life, we try to fill it with earthly things such as money, power, lust and glory as our treasures until the day we bury our dead bodies with them. God's promise of eternal life seems too far removed from our daily struggles. So, just like those three disciples, it's easy for us to make our faith into just holding on to the cultures and rituals and grieving over our less than perfect life stolen from us.

But the reality is, that the tomb is empty because Christ is Risen. He is out the door. He didn't come back to life to stay in His tomb. He came back to lead us out of our tombs. We are not here to find and weep over the dead body of Christ or over our dead faith and hopeless life. We are here to meet and eat and become the Risen and Living Body of Christ. He is as alive as you and I with His Sacred Heart beating toward Heaven and going out to the needy souls thirsting for His Presence and Love. We must fill this empty tomb with His Spirit by giving ourselves generously to God and our neighbors as He did for us.

Jesus died for you and is risen for you! On this day of Easter, and every first day of the week, Jesus will open your tombs and make you rise to a new life in Him. Come to Mass in person. Come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and let Jesus roll away the stones

of your tomb. Let Him come and take you by hand and lead you into His Light. Leave your old self behind. Believe that you are free at last. Because on this day, the Lord is Risen, and we rise with Him.


