"My sheep hear my voice" John 10:27-30

Today we celebrate "Good Shepherd Sunday" and Mother's Day! Jesus is our Good Shepherd who lovingly watches over us, guides us and leads us to peaceful pastures. He knows each of His sheep by name and His sheep know Him. In the very first line of today's gospel Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice". I began to ponder the significant difference between "listening" to the Word of God and actually "hearing" the Word of God. It reminded me of a game I used to play as a child called, "telephone", where a group of us would gather in a circle and one person would begin the game by making a simple statement that would be whispered in the ear of the person sitting right next to you, who would then pass the phrase around to next person until everyone had the words whispered in their ear. The last person to receive the whispered message would declare it to the group and 9 times out of the 10 the message was completely distorted, sometimes not even close to its original truth. How



could that happen? Perhaps it is because though we were listening, we really were not focused on the message and therefore did not *hear* with clarity and in the process the message was lost or distorted. It is not easy to hear: we get distracted by things around us or we are so focused on what we want to say, that it is hard to have the openness to listen to someone else. It also takes time to hear and we may be in a hurry.

Are there people in your own life that you should be giving time to really listen to and hear their heart? I had a friend who suffered a tragic loss in her life and there were no words to comfort her. What she needed was a listening ear and a loving presence to really hear her. It's been said that people don't lose intimacy when they stop talking, but when they stop listening and really hearing the heart of another.

This is also true when we attend Mass and listen to the readings. God speaks to us through His Word and through the priest as he delivers his homily. I asked myself, how often have I let my mind wander during Mass as I review my "to do list" for the day or become distracted by my apple watch that alerts me to texts, emails or phone calls or by the people around me? In the process, I have been unable to hear what God wanted to teach me that day. A few years ago we had Matthew Kelly come to speak at Saint Michael's and he challenged us to bring a journal to Mass each week, and to write one thing we "heard" that moved us. I was so excited to embark on this challenge that I got myself a journal and began this process. I found that as I listened, I was able to hear what God wanted me to learn that day but...I got out of the habit of bringing the journal with me! I am going to try and re-establish the wonderful habit of journaling!

The first disciples had Jesus in the flesh whom they listened to and sometimes they had trouble hearing what He was telling them. Jesus knew their hearts and was able to help them understand who He was and what God called Him to do. We, too can receive clarity from Jesus as we hear the Scriptures proclaimed at Mass and when we listen to the homily. We can also hear the voice of Jesus in our conscience, that inner voice that guides us, directs us and corrects us! He speaks to us through good spiritual friends. Though my mom has died, I still hear her loving voice as she comforted me when I was distraught, directed me when I went astray and encouraged me to put always God first in my life. Perhaps the greatest way we can hear, really hear God is to be still and silent! It is often in the silence that God speaks most clearly and directly!

As we reflect upon Jesus as our Good Shepherd, may we be comforted knowing that He always listens to us and always hears us! Unlike us, He is never distracted by worldly things. He is there for us 24/7 and He longs for us to be there with Him in the sheep pen being guided, protected and loved unconditionally. And as we spend time with Jesus, our Good Shepherd, may we slow down, be still and silent and in that silence come to know the depths of His love for us.

Today we ask God to bless all mothers. They too are shepherds who lovingly care for the children God has given them. May they know how much they are loved and appreciated not only by God but by the family they care for.

Wishing you all God's abundant blessings as you spend time not only listening to Him but really hearing Him.






St. Michael Parish **Bread & Roses Ministry**
