



*The Betrothed* is an Italian historical novel by Alessandro Manzoni, first published in 1827, in three volumes, and significantly revised and rewritten until the definitive version published between 1840 and 1842. It has been called the most famous and widely read novel in the Italian language.

Set in Lombardy in 1628, during the years of Spanish rule, the novel is also noted for its extraordinary description of the plague that struck Milan around 1630.

The novel deals with a variety of themes, from the illusory nature of political power to the inherent injustice of any legal system, from the cowardly, hypocritical nature of one prelate (the parish priest don Abbondio) and the heroic sainthood of other priests (the friar Padre Cristoforo, the Cardinal St. Charles Borromeo) to the unwavering strength of love (the relationship between Renzo and Lucia, and their struggle to finally meet again and be married.) The novel is renowned for offering keen insights into the meanderings of the human mind.

In May 2015, at a weekly general audience at St. Peter's Square, Pope Francis asked engaged couples to read the novel for edification before marriage. Nonetheless, it is edifying for all who read it, a great scholastic work that reveals our ordeal in the 21<sup>st</sup> century COVID pandemic being in many ways similar to that of our ancestors, victims of the Bubonic Plague of 1630!

# PASTORAL REFLECTION

We Americans know what we want. Our meat must be cooked just right just for ourselves. We have favorite drinks, favorite cereals, favorite TV shows, movies and songs, and favorite vacation spots. All our life, we have nurtured our tastes for things that give us the maximum satisfaction. We know what we want. Our focus is on ourselves. So, when Jesus today tells us, “Love one another”, for many of us, it means loving people who make us feel good without too much inconvenience to our lifestyle.

However, Jesus adds, “As I have loved you”. Jesus wants us to love in a very specific way. First, Jesus wanted to free us from the bondage to sins that lead to death. His Love was free from sins and free to walk toward God. His love was free. Second, Jesus loved us without holding anything back for Himself. His Love was total. Third, Jesus loved us not expecting anything back for Himself. He said instead, Love one another. In other words, pay it forward. Spread and multiply the love. His Love was fruitful.

Now, we know our love should be free, total, and fruitful. But we are not saints. At least not yet. That is why Paul said, “It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God.” It doesn't happen overnight. It is unlikely that we can pull off heroic love from the beginning. We must train. That's why we call ourselves “practicing Catholics”. It is a term for those who are in the training camp. When we admit that we have relapsed with our addiction to selfish love, God washes us with His blood and says, “Let us try again.” By never giving up, our love becomes faithful.

This teaching that Love of Christ is free, total, fruitful, and faithful is not my idea. St. Pope John Paul II gave us the Theology of the Body to teach us how to love in this time when not all love is the Love Jesus commanded us to imitate. We come back to Eucharist to keep perfecting our Love. There is no other way. Jesus never gives up on us. He will show up, and He will put Himself in our Body, and blow His Spirit in us. Let us give another go to love one another as He has loved us.






