


The traveling Visitation of the Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe has been rescheduled to Friday, January 28th. Details to follow shortly.



Recently an article appeared in the *Beacon* regarding a service project that a St.Rose pupil organized. The student highlighted is Grade 6 pupil Rachel Dias who has attended St.Rose of Lima School since the age of five. To her parents Rachel expressed a desire to help give those children at Hasbro Children's Hospital a nicer Christmas.



Rachel has been making pillows for years so at Thanksgiving time she decided to make a lot of her hand-made pillows to be sold as a means to raise money for the children at Hasbro. At \$5 a pillow Rachel met her goal by raising \$700. Her father Mathew Dias who is employed by AAANortheast arranged for a \$500 donation from his company too. On December 22nd Rachel and her mother Kayla, who is the PreK3 teacher at St.Rose of Lima school presented Hasbro with a check for \$700 and AAA Northeast donated \$500, with a grand total of \$1,200. The funds were used to provide entertainment for children at the hospital on Christmas. The time and effort that Rachel gave to the community and the support her parents provided her in her decision emulates the type of values that we strive to instill in our students at St.Rose. Rachel is living out our mission in her service to the local community.


