### **DIOCESAN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION:**

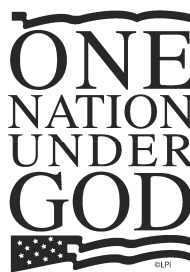
