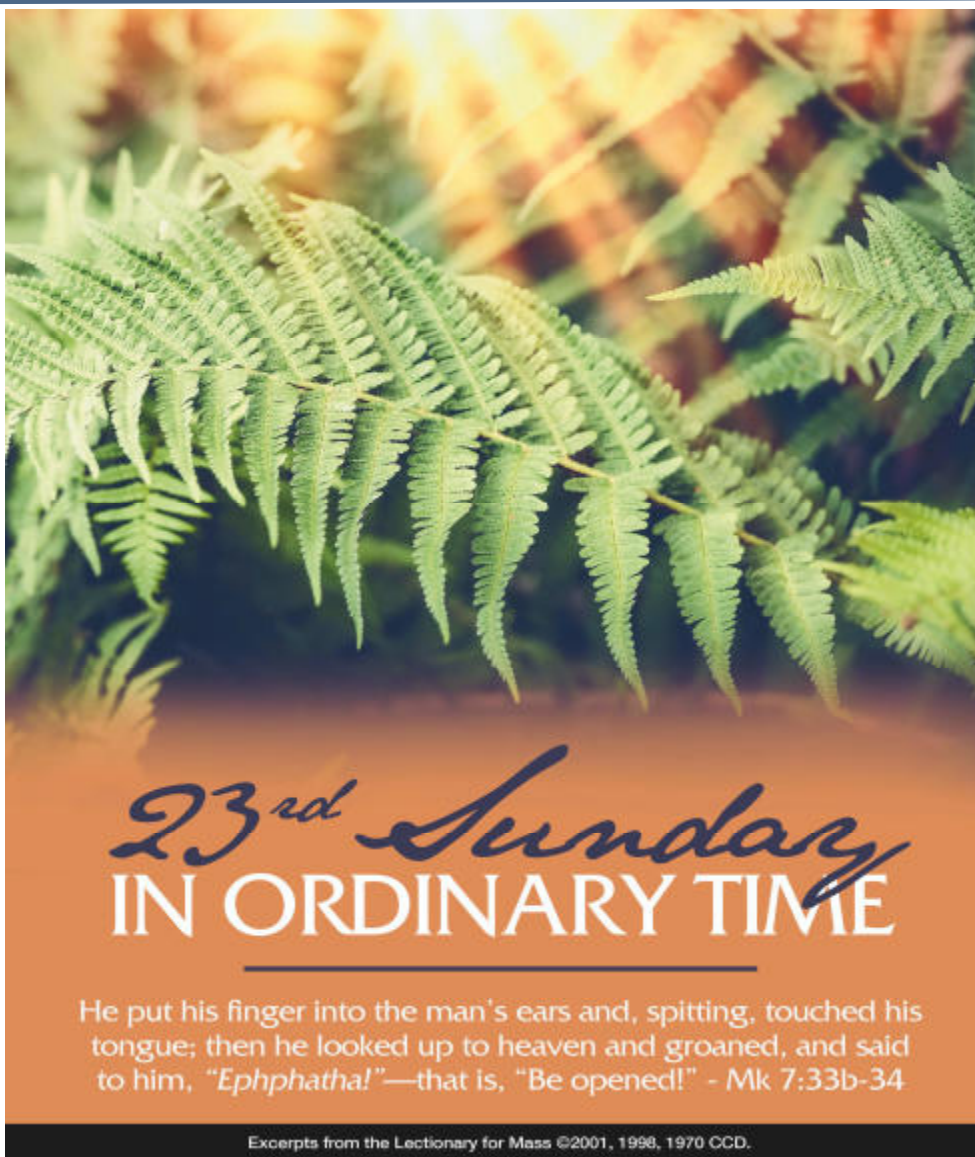

DIOCESE OF PROVIDENCE CELEBRATES 150 YEARS

Beginning September 8, 2021 and lasting until June, 26, 2022, the Diocese of Providence will host an ongoing celebration of the sesquicentennial of its founding in February, 1872. The central theme of the celebration is rooted in the sacred scripture of Psalm 126: "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy." The diocesan celebration will begin on Wednesday, September 8, 2021, the feast of the Nativity of Our Lady, with "A Night to Honor Mary" beginning at 6 PM in the Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul. Bishop Thomas J. Tobin will lead the diocese in this Marian devotion through prayer, readings from Sacred Scripture, the Holy Rosary, and a litany and procession. A small reception will follow.
