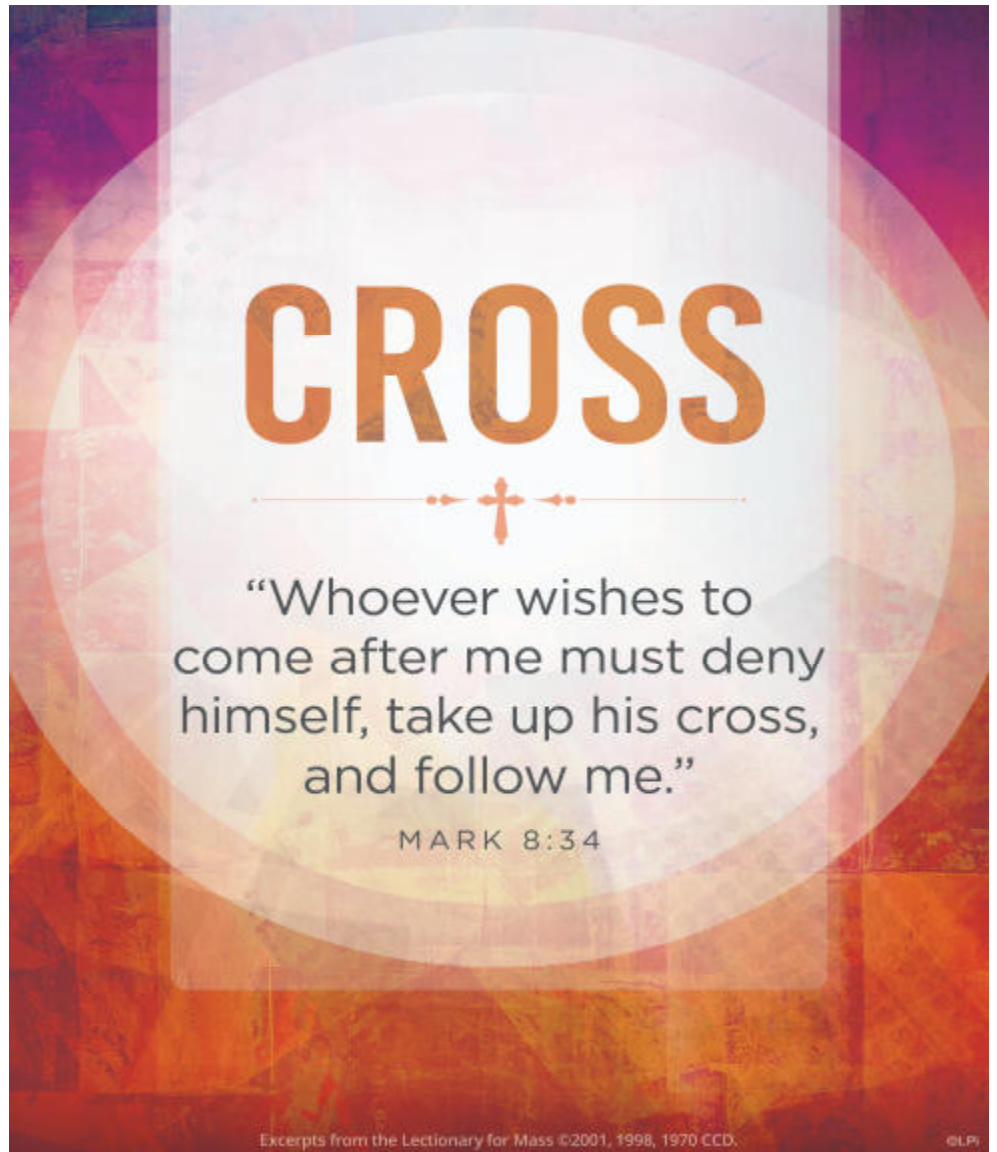

## SILVER ROSE PRAYER SERVICE

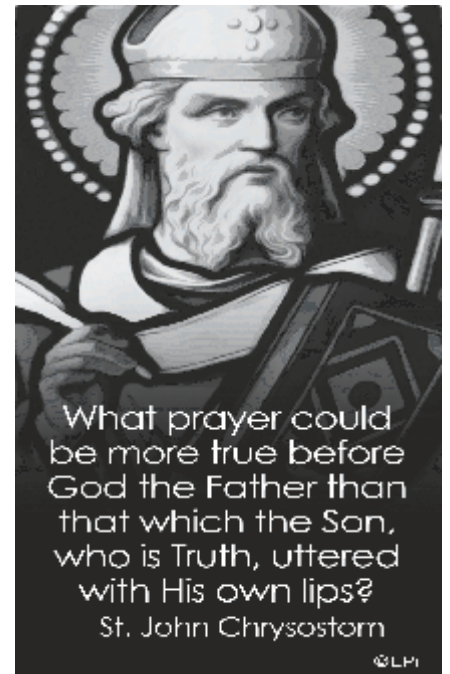
