

STATEMENT OF BISHOP THOMAS TOBIN ON THE MASK MANDATES IN RI On December 15, Bishop Tobin issued the following instruction: As *it has from the beginning of the pandemic, the Diocese of Providence will continue to cooperate fully with state directives regarding the response to the pandemic. Accordingly, I encourage Catholics of the Diocese of Providence to follow state guidelines and to wear a mask whenever they are attending Holy Mass, and other church services or public programs. In addition, in keeping with our approved policies, liturgical ministers (e.g. priests, deacons, ministers of Holy Communion, altar servers, cantors, and choir members) are not expected to wear masks while actively participating in the liturgy. ANNUAL RESPECT FOR LIFE MASS


