Lent, the season of spiritual preparation for the high holy days of the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

The tried-and-true way of observing a "good Lent" is threefold: prayer, fasting and giving.

#### 1. Prayer:

Lenten Adult Faith Formation Program see details on page 2.

Rosary Evenings: Sundays at 7PM at St. Paul's. Open to any and all who would like to pray the rosary in a group setting. If you would like to learn how to pray the rosary, leaders arrive a few minutes early to offer guidance

Stations of the Cross: every Friday at 5:00 pm: St. Joseph's 3/18, 4/1, Note 4/15 Good Friday at 3pm, and St. Paul's 3/25, 4/8 The Little Black Book: (one per family) are located near the church entrances for you to pick up and use through the Lenten season.

- 2. Fast & Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. As a sign of our penance, we preserve for the Diocese of Albany the custom of abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence binds all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Fast binds all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally, fasting calls for only one full meal per day.
- <u>3. Giving:</u> Rice Bowls This Lent our parish is again participating in Catholic Relief Service's (CRS) Rice Bowl, a faith-in-action program that helps families experience Lenten spirituality by living in solidarity with people in need around the world.
  - \* Place your CRS Rice Bowl in a prominent place in your home and use it to collect your Lenten sacrifices. Return it on Easter.

\* Read the Lenten calendar reflections each day as a family.

#### St. Joseph's & St. Paul's Adult Parish Lenten Study Program

There is still time to join us this Lent as we walk step-by-step with Christ from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary. Filmed in the Holy Land with Dr. Edward Sri, this five-part study reveals how Old Testament prophecies, messianic expectations, historical realities and powerful symbolism come together in awe-inspiring fashion to reveal God's unfathomable love for us.

Our group meets Wednesday evenings at 7:00 PM in St. Joseph's church hall. We started on March 16<sup>th</sup>, (original start date of 3/9 was cancelled due to bad weather) and the fifth and final session will be on April 13<sup>th</sup>, the Wednesday of Holy Week.
