Historical Presentation: Forgotten Crossroads - Rock City Falls

#### **New Date and Location**

#### Friday, May 13th, 7 pm at Rock City Falls Firehouse Free / Open to the Public / No Reservations Required

This is the first of a series of "Forgotten Crossroads of Saratoga County" videos, co-sponsored by the History Center and the Saratoga County History Roundtable. This 20 minute video on Rock City Falls is designed to document the development of this once vibrant community, what attracted families to settle here in the late 18th and 19th centuries, and how it grew around the mills, taverns, schools, stores, churches, and farms. The film concludes with a segment on the contemporary community that still works and lives there.

This video was developed under the leadership of Milton Town Historian Karen Staulters and was produced by Anne Clothier of the Saratoga County History Center. The presentation will include a behind-the-scenes look at the creation of the film.
