From the Catechism of the Catholic Church on the Salvation of children not yet baptized:

1261 As regards children who have died without Baptism, the Church can only entrust them to the mercy of God, as she does in her funeral rites for them. Indeed, the great mercy of God who desires that all men should be saved, and Jesus' tenderness toward children which caused him to say: "Let the children come to me, do not hinder them," [Mk 10:14; cf. 1 Tim 2:4] allow us to hope that there is a



way of salvation for children who have died without Baptism. All the more urgent is the Church's call not to prevent little children coming to Christ through the gift of holy Baptism.

A Note about becoming a Sponsor for Baptism and Confirmation

It is a great honor to be asked to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation. The role of a "godparent" is to be an "other parent" in matters of our holy Faith. That is why sponsors should be practicing Catholics, 16 years of age or older, must have received Confirmation and currently living a good Christian moral life. If a sponsor is married, that person should have participated in a valid Church marriage. A nominated sponsor may be asked to get certification from his/her parish where they currently reside. The certificate explains that the individual is qualified to be a sponsor, a current parishioner of the particular parish where they are living, and be known to the priest as being a faithful, practicing Catholic, attending Mass there weekly. Here at St. Francis of Assisi, Certificates of Sponsorship are given by the pastor to REGISTERED MEMBERS of the parish who are practicing Catholics and who meet the above criteria. Please see the pastor to inquire about getting a certificate.




