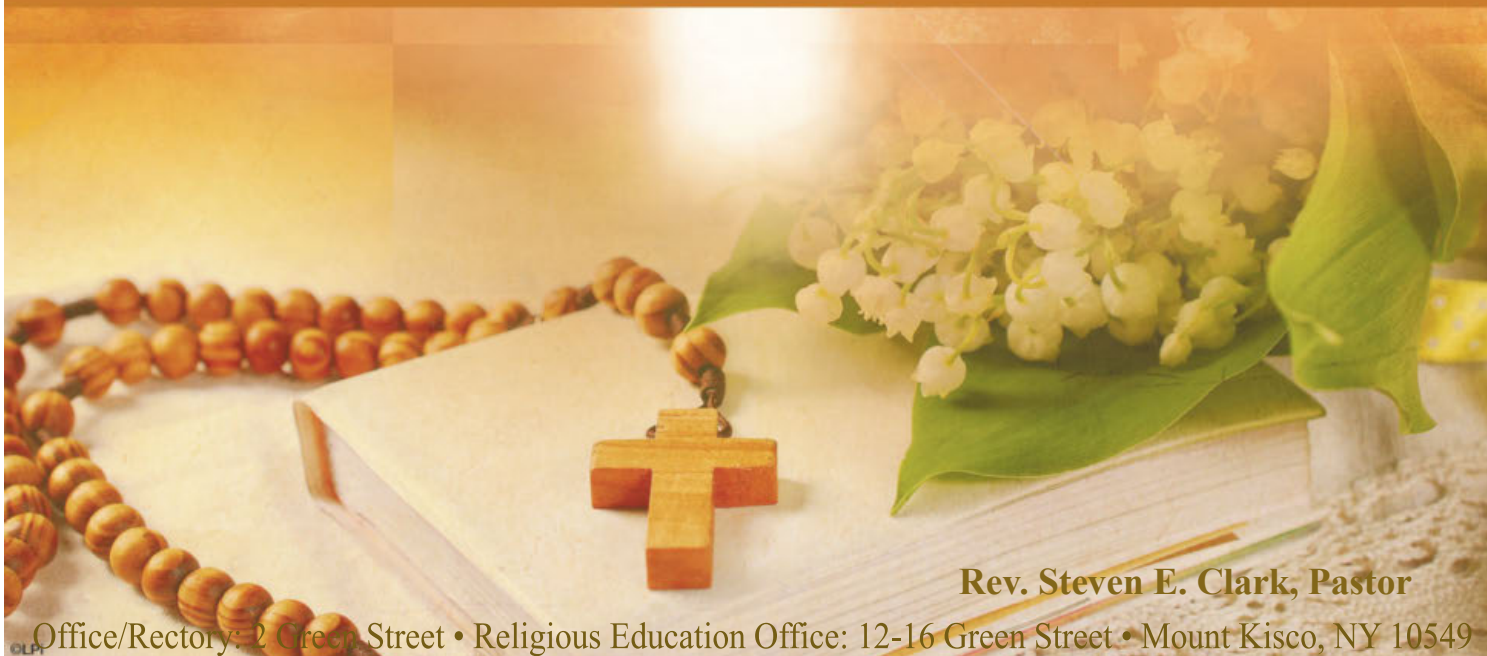

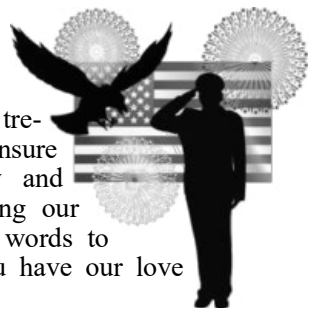

From the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* on the *Significance of the Resurrection of Jesus*:

653 The truth of Jesus' divinity is confirmed by his Resurrection. He had said: "When you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he." [Jn 8:28] The Resurrection of the crucified one shows that he was truly "I AM," the Son of God and God himself. So St. Paul could declare to the Jews: "What God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus; as also it is written in the second psalm, 'You are my Son, today I have begotten you.'" [Acts 13:32. 34; cf. Ps 2:7] Christ's Resurrection is closely linked to the Incarnation of God's Son, and is its fulfillment in accordance with God's eternal plan.

Letter of Sponsorship for Baptism & Confirmation

We receive many requests for "Sponsorship Letters" from people who have little or no association with St. Francis of Assisi. In order for us to honestly testify to your good standing as a parishioner, these are the requirements:

- Be an active, registered parishioner for at least 6 months. This means, you must attend Mass regularly, you are committed to stewardship of your time, talent and financial resources to our parish and the Archdiocese of NY
- You **must** have received the sacraments of Baptism & Confirmation
- If married, it must be a recognized marriage by the Catholic Church.

(Note: Letters or certificates should come from the parish where you currently reside.)

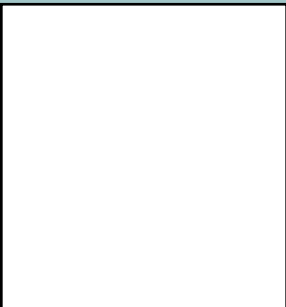
