I DIDN'T KNOW THAT!!??

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church on the Ascension of Jesus to His Father in Heaven:

660 The veiled character of the glory of the Risen One during this time [of the resurrection] is intimated in his mysterious

words to Mary Magdalene: "I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to my brethren and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." [Jn 20:17] This indicates a difference in manifestation between the glory of the risen Christ and that of the Christ exalted to the Father's right hand, a transition marked by the historical and transcendent event of the Ascension.



661 This final stage stays closely linked to the first, that is, to his descent from heaven in the Incarnation. Only the one who "came from the Father" can return to the Father: Christ Jesus. [Cf. Jn 16:28] "No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man." [Jn 3:13; cf. Eph 4:8-10] Left to its own natural powers humanity does not have access to the "Father's house," to God's life and happiness. [Jn 14:2] Only Christ can open to man such access that we, his members, might have confidence that we too shall go where he, our Head and our Source, has preceded us. [Missale Romanum, Preface of the Ascension]




