

ST. PAUL VI PARISH - 4TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME JANUARY 30, 2022



Dear Friends,

On Monday evening, after I had finished benediction following confessions, I was joined by Father Mauricio to put away the *accoutrement* needed for benediction and to lock the church. (Msgr. Joe was at the online Alpha course.) Now the tasks of closing the church seem easy and they would be if we knew what keys worked where and what closet or cabinets to use! We were quite proud of our selves as we locked all the doors, shut the lights and put everything away.

As we were leaving we heard voices. Please do not worry they were real and they were coming from the basement. We went down to investigate and we found six or seven parishioners who were working in the food pantry in the basement of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church. They happily explained who they were and what they were doing. I was impressed by the care they were showing for the least fortunate among us and their commitment to the ministry at hand.

Then, suddenly I had an epiphany! This was Church and parish all at once in so many forms and examples. Let me explain, so often we think of parish as the place we attend Mass on Sunday. The Sunday Eucharist is foundational to the parish life; but flowing from the Eucharist is all that makes a parish. It is benediction after extended periods of communal prayer both at St. Rita all day Monday and the hour on Monday evening at OLMC. It is the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation which even though intimate and private is an expression of Church. It is the online Alpha course where hundreds of Hamden Catholics have deepened their faith. It is collecting and distributing food for the hungry at OLMC, at St. Rita, at St. Ann Food Pantry. The parish is the sixth grade teacher explaining science at the school. The parish is the catechist sharing the faith with children and their families. The parish is the group of people helping at funerals and weddings. The parish is a dinner or a Knights of Columbus meeting or a Bible Study. The parish is singing and praising. The parish is active and evangelizing.

St. Paul VI wrote: The task of evangelizing all people constitutes the essential mission of the Church. It is a task and mission which the vast and profound changes of present-day society make all the more urgent. Evangelizing is in fact the grace and vocation proper to the Church, her deepest identity. She exists in order to evangelize. (Apostolic exhortation: On evangelization in the modern world, December 8, 1975)

All of these moments of parish life were evangelizing moments! Let us be about Evangelization here in Hamden and beyond. Let us share the good news.

Each and every week, in fact every time we celebrate Mass, the bread and wine becomes the Body and Blood of Christ. We receive the Lord and this great mystery needs to be shared with all; that is our task as a Catholic community, here in Hamden and beyond.

Thank you for all you do for our parish.
