

January 2, 2022

The Epiphany of the Lord

The Feast of the Epiphany it is the day that Jesus was introduced to the Gentile world. If I check the dictionary for a definition of "epiphany" the first one is the visitation of the wise men on this twelfth day of Christmas, and another defines it as an "aha" moment. For the Jewish community reading this passage from Matthew, it's an "aha" that non-Jews are included in salvation. We kind of take that for granted but sometimes we, too, think that some are meant for salvation more than others. So, this feast is meant to shake up our prejudices as well. But what else can this feast day mean to us? Think back to the moment when you accepted your faith as your own and not just what others had taught you to believe. Perhaps it was a gradual realization that what you have been taught over the years was true. Perhaps it was a particular event of joy or sadness that caused you to welcome Jesus into your heart. This was your epiphany. Although I had practiced my faith from the time that I was a small child, I remember vividly the day that I understood what it meant to be loved unconditionally by God. I remember the freedom I felt as well as the responsibility. I felt free because I knew that I would not be loved more by being "good" and that I would never be loved less if I sinned. Wow! But I also felt that I needed to respond to that powerful love by being the best person possible. I realized that I had been created for a purpose and that I needed to live my life praying that God would show me the path he had meant for me to follow. As you think back to your epiphany, consider what it has meant in your life and what it means for your future.


Our parishes offer a supportive program to assist parents to pass on Our Catholic Faith to the families of our parishes. Our program is interactive, prayerful, and instructional.


We offer-
