


Mission Appeal 2021 St Basil the Great Parish

Dear Friends,

Greetings and blessings from Bishop Joseph Kallarangatt, the Diocese of Palai, The mission appeal is to fund a Hospice Care center which has 80 beds. Birth and death are the two most significant events in the life of any person. Till a few decades ago, most of the births in our country took place at home, in a rudimental setting, without professional medical support, causing unto!d sufferings to the mother. Nowadays, even in a developing country like India, most of the births happen in hospitals. The same is not true as far as deaths are concerned.

Most of the deaths, be they due to terminal diseases or advanced age, continue to happen at home. Patients are usually taken care of in their final days by their relatives at home. Terminal patients, once curative treatment is ruled out by hospitals, have no choice, except to return home. Obviously, due to financial constraints and lack of technical expertise those at home are incapable of offering proper care and support to the patients. It is in this backdrop that the Diocese of Palai has come up with the plan to build a hospice care center attached to the recently inaugurated hospital at Cherpumkal, just five kilometers away from the diocesan headquarters. The first of its kind in the whole district, it will be directly managed by the diocese and staffed by religious sisters. The diocese is not in a position to finance this project all alone as it involves substantia! initial and running expenses. The Covid pandemic affected our economy very much. People are dying on the streets. Many active priests and nuns of the diocese passed away. The pandemic caused the largest national recession in history, with more than a third of the national population at this time being placed on lockdown. That is why! make an appeal, on beha!f of the bishop of Palai, to the generosity of the people of St. Basil the Great Parish, Wolcott. Incidentally, the first hospice in the United States was founded in the State of Connecticut. Help us realize our dream project to alleviate the sufferings of terminally ill people. Help us to become the pioneers of a new culture of life in our own place. May God bless you, your family, and your parish abundantly with good health, peace joy and happiness. God bless America!

Consecration to Jesus Through Mary



Beginning on Saturday, September 4th, men, women, and children from around the Archdiocese of Hartford will be uniting in prayer, joining together virtually to take part in a 33-Day Consecration to Jesus through Mary. Groups from our Catholic schools, faith formation programs, and parishes are planning to take part in this Consecration, which will be steered by the book Child Consecration: To Jesus through Mary – Following in the Spirit of St. Thérèse, the Little Flower and led by the clergy and shepherds of our Archdiocese, including Archbishop Blair, Bishop Betancourt, and priests and deacons from numerous parishes. Each day from September 4 to October 7 individuals may participate in the Consecration in three possible ways: 1. Pray the Consecration with the book Child Consecration: To Jesus through Mary -Following in the Spirit of St. Thérèse, the Little Flower. 2. Visit childconsecration.com, for daily readings. and prayers. 3. Watch on the Fiat Ministry Network YouTube Channel. Each day the Archdiocese of Hartford will lead that day's portion of the Consecration beginning at 8:00 PM. Each day's video clip will remain available to view for anyone who missed it.

This Sunday is called **Catechetical Sunday**, a day when we recognize all those who share their Gift of Faith in the teaching ministry of the Church. 
