

This weekend **December 18th and 19th** the Little Sisters of the Poor will be visiting our parish. The collection taken for them will be exclusively for the care of the elderly poor who reside with them at St. Joseph's Residence in Enfield. The Little Sisters of the Poor have been serving the needs of the elderly poor in Connecticut and Western Massachusetts for over 100 years. They are most grateful for your generosity.

Since the congregation began in France in the 1800's by St. Jeanne Jugan, the Little Sisters of the Poor have consistently served the needs of the poor and elderly. They continue to be dependent upon the generosity of friends and benefactors to provide a safe and caring home for the elderly whom we serve. One of the important ways they receive donations for St. Joseph's Residence in Enfield is through annual collections at individual parishes. These collections afford parishioners the opportunity to hear about the work of the Little Sisters of the Poor and of the needs of the elderly poor whom they serve. It is also an opportunity for the Little Sisters of the Poor to appeal to parishioners for vocations to the religious life.



It is said that starting in the 16th century in England Catholics were being persecuted and it was illegal to practice the faith. So The "12 days of Christmas" song was written as a secret code to help teach children their Catechism. 12 Days of Christmas Song Symbols for Catholics.

- 1. Partridge in a pear tree- Jesus on the cross
- 2. Two turtle doves- the Old and New Testaments of the Bible
- 3. Three French hens- the 3 theological virtues from 1 Corinthians 13:13- Faith, Hope, and Love
- 4. Four calling birds- the 4 Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John
- 5. Five golden rings- the Pentateuch (or first five books of the old Testament) Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy
- 6. Six geese a laying- the 6 days of creation
- 7. Seven swans a swimming- the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord)
- 8. Eight maids a milking- the 8 beatitudes given to us by Jesus during his sermon on the mount.
- 9. Nine ladies dancing- the 9 fruits of the spirit as listed in Galatians 5:22-23
- 10. Ten lords a leaping- the 10 Commandments
- Eleven pipers piping- the 11 faithful apostles
- 12. Twelve drummers drumming- the 12 points of faith from the Apostles' Creed
