- 3. Upon our darkness, Lord, a light has shone. You chose to dwell with us in flesh and bone.



From the Pastor Desk

As we welcome in the New Year, I begin a new and exciting chapter in my life as Pastor of two wonderful parishes: St. Basil the Great in Wolcott and Mary, Mother of the Church in Waterbury. Archbishop Blair has appointed me as Pastor of Mary, Mother of the Church beginning this Wednesday, January 5, 2022 in addition to my duties as Pastor of St. Basil the Great Parish.

With this appointment comes some adjustments for all of us. We will be continuing to celebrate Daily Mass at St. Basil the Great at 8 a.m. on Mondays and Tuesdays. The Daily Mass we be celebrated at St. Leo the Great at 8 a.m. on Wednesdays and Thursday each week. Both St. Basil the Great and St. Leo the Great will have Confessions at 3 p.m. on Saturday evening before the 4 p.m. Vigil Mass. Sunday Mass will be at 8 a.m. at SS. Peter and Paul, 9:30 a.m. at St. Basil the Great and 11 a.m. at St. Leo the Great. Having only one Sunday Mass at St. SS. Peter and Paul and St. Basil the Great will take some adjustment on the part of us all and I truly appreciate your willingness to make the change to your schedule. St. Leo the Great will continue to have one Sunday Mass, however it will be at a new time at 11.a.m.

I am very excited about this new appointment. I have deep ties with both SS. Peter and Paul and St. Leo the Great Parishes. When my family first moved to Waterbury from Philadelphia in December of 1973, we attended SS. Peter and Paul Church. After Father Spodnik was appointed by Archbishop Whealon to establish a new parish, my family and I became parishioners of St. Leo the Great. I was present when Archbishop Whealon dedicated St. Leo the Great Church on December 12, 1976 and I was honored to celebrate my First Mass at St. Leo the Great on February 10, 1985. Throughout the years I have worked closely with Father Spodnik, Father Gorman, Monsignor Coleman and Father Lavorgna. From 2005 until 2010, I was Pastor of Our Lady of Loreto Parish in Waterbury and truly felt that I was coming home. I have those same feelings once again.

I will continue to reside at St. Pius X Rectory in Wolcott and I will have office hours at SS. Peter and Paul Rectory. I know that the idea of sharing a pastor is new to us all. Let's work together to make the transition smooth and to build on the great foundation that already exists, namely two wonderful parishes not too far from one another giving praise to the Lord, receiving the sacraments and working together to build up the Body of Christ, which is the Church. We pray through the intercession of our patrons, SS. Peter and Paul, St. Leo the Great and St. Basil the Great. In addition, we invoke the intercession of St. John Neumann, Bishop of Philadelphia, my city of birth and whose Feast Day is January 5th. We also pray to Blessed Michael J. McGivney a native son of Waterbury that this new adventure will be a true blessing for us all.




NEW YEAR THANK YOU 2022
