



both current and future parishioners, especially our youth to increase their service to God and our Parish. They offer us great opportunity to preserve and grow the catholic community of Wolcott.

Technology: We need to move the Parish forward with the use of current and future technology developments, especially the use of video transmission of Parish events. In addition to live streaming Mass we see great benefit to also use technology to live stream of weddings, funerals, on-line classes and guest speakers.

Adult Education: Programs, lectures and chat rooms to enhance the knowledge of all Parishioners will benefits the Parish immensely in the future. This would include a RCIA program to assist adults who want to join the Catholic faith and our Parish. It offers fallen away Catholics the opportunity to come back to the Church and our Parish.

Youth Outreach and Ministry: Develop church and community service programs to increase youth involvement.

Capital Improvements: Construct two lavatories that will be more handicaps accessible.

This will offer parishioners a quiet place to sit and pray.



The Baptism of the Lord

This feast marks the ending of

the Christmas season. Traditionally, the event of Christ's baptism was linked with the visit of the Magi and the wedding feast of Cana as two additional "manifestations" of God with us.

Matthew's simple account of the baptism ends with the heavenly voice introducing "my beloved Son." Here, at the end of our focus on the mystery of Christmas, we are invited to welcome the Beloved One into our midst once more, and to prepare ourselves through the Sundays which follow to hear his proclamation of Good News.

Many have expressed the wish that the spirit of Christmas last all through the year. Christians take that responsibility seriously: We want to make the meaning of Christmas—the fact that God has come to dwell with us in Jesus Christ—the central fact of life. And, we want all we say and do to help express, to make manifest, that basic truth. Merry Christmas, one more time!

who are adult Catholics who themselves have been confirmed; are registered parishioners who attend Mass every Sunday; are validly married in the Church (if married); and are providing for the Faith Formation of their own children (if applicable).
