The week begins on Monday January 18<sup>th</sup> to January 25<sup>th</sup> 2022. The theme this hear is "Abide in My Love...You Shall Bear Much Fruit" Prayer is simply talking to God and it's

one way we communicate with Him. Prayer is how we are able to repent and ask for forgiveness as well as give him praise. We often pray for people who are sick and ask God to heal them. Matthew 21:22 says, "If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer." The most common prayer among Christians is the "Lord's Prayer", which according to the gospel accounts (e.g. Matthew 6:9-13) is how Jesus taught his disciples to pray. There are two basic settings for Christian prayer: corporate public & private.



In today's Gospel, Jesus stands in the synagogue reading from the scroll handed to Him that contain the words of the prophet Isaiah. At this early moment in His ministry, Jesus announces His mission. This reading from Isaiah de-

fines Jesus' ministry, that includes bringing glad tidings to the poor, liberty to captives, healing to the sick, freedom to the oppressed, and proclaiming a year acceptable to the Lord.

The Kingdom of God is now at hand! It is made present in Jesus, in His life, death, and Resurrection. Jesus will send the Holy Spirit so that the Kingdom of God can be fulfilled. The Holy Spirit is Jesus' gift to the Church. The Holy Spirit enables the Church to continue the mission of Christ. When we share with those in need, care for the sick, and pray for all to be free ~ we serve the Kingdom of God on earth!
