
ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA! LET THE HOLY ANTHEM RISE

 Who is risen up today!



The relegation to profane but not sordid use of Saint Maria Goretti Church in Wolcott Connecticut

On June 6, 2022, the church of Saint Maria Goretti, located at 1300 Woodtick Road, Wolcott, Connecticut, will be relegated to profane but not sordid use in accordance with canon 1222 §2. On April 26, 2022, Archbishop Leonard P. Blair issued a decree effecting the relegation that Saint Maria Goretti Church is no longer a sacred place for divine worship.

During the weekend of May 14/15, 2022, the decree will be read at all Masses, and its substance will be communicated to all parishioners by means of a notice in the weekend bulletin of Saint Basil the Great Parish, Wolcott, including the display in appropriate places at the churches, so that parishioners can read it as they enter or exit the churches. It will also be available on the Archdiocese of Hartford website, under the News/Public Notices Section, [https://archdioceseofhartford.org/public-notices/]. Canonical recourse may be made within the peremptory time limit of ten (10) business days from the legitimate notification of the decree and in accordance with the norm of law (c. 1734 §2).

MOST REVEREND LEONARD P. BLAIR ARCHBISHOP OF HARTFORD

DECREEIn Nomine Domini. Amen.

This decree concerns the relegation to profane but not sordid use of Saint Maria Goretti Church building in Wolcott, Connecticut.

WHEREAS, by my decree of May 2, 2017, the parishes of Saint Pius X and Saint Maria Goretti merged and formed Saint Basil the Great Parish, with two sacred edifices;

WHEREAS, no recourse was filed against this decree;

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2022, the pastor of Saint Basil the Great Parish, supported by the trustees and Finance Council, requested by letter that Saint Maria Goretti Church be relegated to profane but not sordid use;

WHEREAS, the letter described the church building of Saint Maria Goretti as a financial burden on the Parish due to the annual operating costs associated with maintaining the church while it is no longer needed for divine worship;

WHEREAS, I convened the Archdiocesan Presbyteral Council on April 25, 2022, for consultation on the question of the relegation of Saint Maria Goretti Church to profane but not sordid use in light of the following facts:

- All other reasonable sources of funding or assistance have been considered and found lacking or inadequate to maintain the church building and facilities in general.
- The strategic pastoral planning for the Archdiocese was to reduce the number of churches so that our local churches are characterized by spiritual vitality, organizational efficacy and accountability, and social and financial responsibility.
 - The number of parishioners has decreased.
 - Closure will not harm the good of souls.
 - Divine worship is adequately provided for at Saint Pius X Church, and Saint Maria Goretti Church is scarcely used.

WHEREAS, the Presbyteral Council voted unanimously to recommend that Saint Maria Goretti Church be relegated to profane but not sordid use;

WHEREAS, I have concluded that the economic hardship of maintaining the building and its lack of usefulness to Saint Basil the Great Parish constitute grave cause sufficient in law to support the relegation of the church building to profane but not sordid use;

WHEREFORE, Having carefully considered the law and the facts, having received a formal written request on February 28, 2022, from the Pastor and the Trustees with the support of the Parish Finance Council, and having heard the Presbyteral Council on April 25, 2022; having ensured by means of the original deeds and other documents as well as having heard from others that there are donors and/or their heirs whose consent is needed to perform this juridic act, in accordance with the norm of canon 1222 §2; thus having safeguarded the intentions/ restrictions of the donors, and having ensured that its altars, sacred objects, and religious artifacts will be removed from the church in accordance with canonical norms;

I, the undersigned Archbishop of Hartford, do pronounce, declare, and **DECREE** that the church of Saint Maria Goretti, located at 1300 Woodtick Road, Wolcott, Connecticut, belonging to Saint Basil the Great Parish, be relegated to profane but not sordid use (c.1222 §2), effective June 6,2022. It shall no longer be a sacred place used for divine worship, and herewith will lose its blessing, dedication, and consecration.

This decree is to be published to the pastor of Saint Basil the Great Parish. The substance of it is to be communicated to parishioners at the aforementioned parish, including by way of a display in an appropriate place so that parishioners can read it as they enter or exit the churches. It will also be available on the Archdiocese of Hartford website, under News-Public Notices: [https://archdioceseothartford.org/public-notices/]. Canonical recourse may be made within the peremptory time limit of ten (10) business days from the legitimate notification of the decree and in accordance with the norm of law (CIC canon 1734 §2).

All things to the contrary notwithstanding.

What a special day to honor Mary, the Mother of Jesus!


