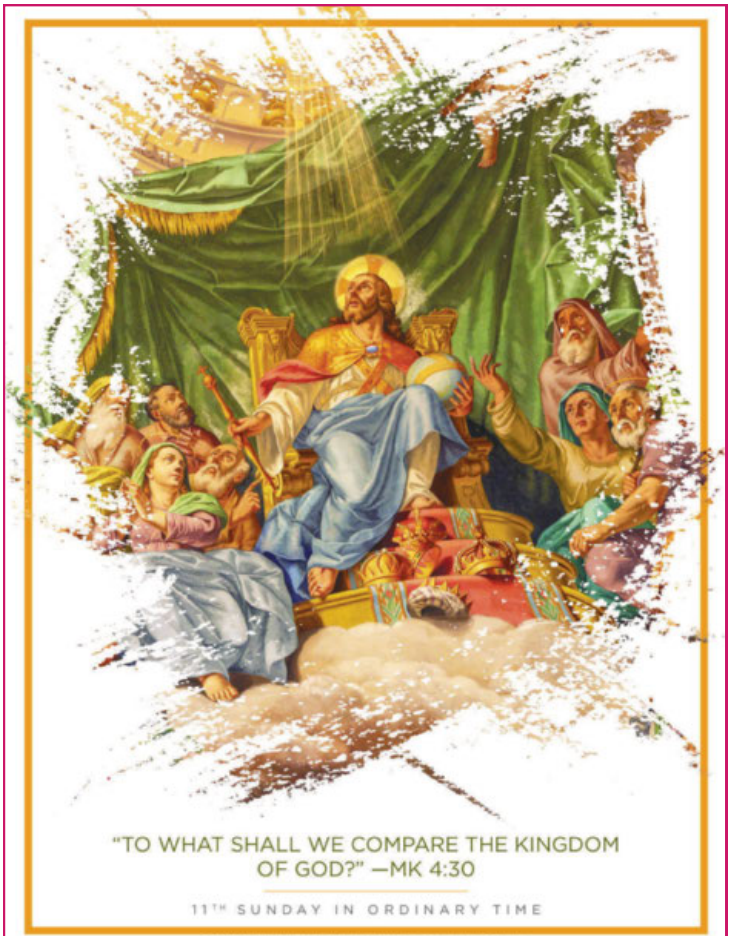

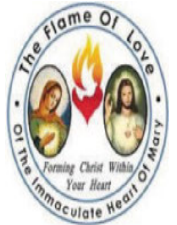

Baltimore Catechism Quiz

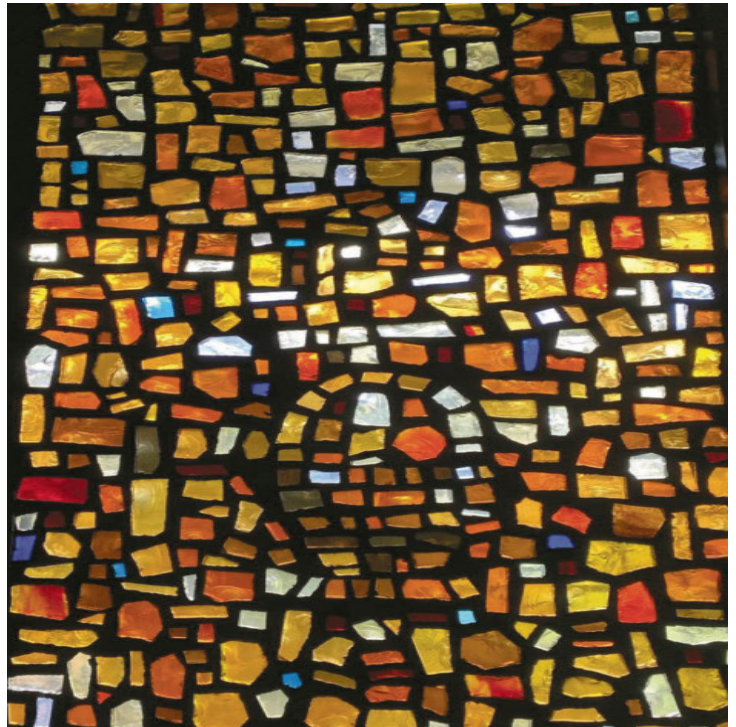
Last week's question/answer:

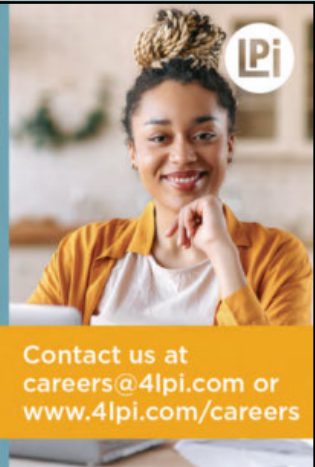
