5 Tips To Keep Your Brain Healthy

Our brains and bodies experience changes as we age. There are many ways to slow the decline in memory and lower your risk of developing Alzheimer's disease.

1. Exercise regularly. Physically active people are less likely to experience a decline in mental function. Try to exercise for about 30 to 60 minutes per week. You can walk, swim, or do any moderate activity that increases your heart rate.
2. Get plenty of sleep. Sleeping may help clear abnormal proteins in your brain and consolidate memories. Try to get 7 to 8 hours of sleep per night.
3. Eat a Mediterranean diet. Diet plays a large role in brain health. A Mediterranean diet consists of plant-based foods, whole grains, fish, and healthy fats like olive oil. It is a diet with less red meat and salt. Omega fatty acids like extra virgin olive oil and other healthy fats are important for your cells to function and also decrease the risk of cardiac disease.
4. Stay mentally active. Your brain is like a muscle- you need to use it or lose it. Some ways to exercise your brain are crossword puzzles, reading, playing cards, or doing a jigsaw puzzle.
5. Remain socially active. Now that we can get out more since covid restrictions are being lifted, try to stay connected to loved ones and friends. Isolation can lead to brain atrophy so being socially active has the opposite effect.
