## FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

**Registration for our 2021-2022 Faith Formation  
is available on our parish website  
[stannsraynham.org](http://stannsraynham.org)**

Parents are reminded that First Communion is a two-year program. Children must attend both grades one and two to be eligible to receive First Communion in Spring of the second year. Children attending parochial school [grades 1-8] are not required to attend classes here at St. Ann's. Parochial school students planning to receive First Communion here at St. Ann's in the Spring 2022, must be parishioners at St. Ann's, and should register at this time. There is a selection specifically for our parochial school students.

Confirmation preparation is a two-year program as well. Students must attend both grades nine and ten to become eligible to receive Confirmation in the spring of their second year of formation. Students enrolled in Catholic high schools ARE required by Diocesan statutes to attend Confirmation classes in their home parishes. These students should be registered at this time.

### TEACHERS NEEDED

This year's Faith Formation will look different than in past years. Grades 1-6 will be formatted like Vacation Bible School where students will switch between stations. Grades 1 & 2 students will receive some program modifications to include their sacramental preparation.

Grades 7 & 8 will connect with their faith using the Lifeteen program. This program strives to make real-world connections to teens as they grow in their faith. This program is conversation and activity driven.

Confirmation I & II will look similar to years past. Mass is still required, however in order to be sensitive to the ongoing pandemic, we will allow students to attend Mass with their families.

- Group 2 (Grades 1-6) – Sundays 9:15-10:45 AM
- Group 3 (Grades 1-6) – Mondays 5:30-7:00 PM
- Group 4 (Grades 1-6) – Tuesdays 5:00-6:30 PM
- Group 5 (Grades 1-6) – Mondays 5:00-6:30 PM
- Group 6 (Grades 1-6) – Tuesdays 5:30-7:00 PM

- Lifeteen I (Grades 7 & 8) – Tuesdays 7:00-8:15 PM
- Lifeteen II (Grades 7 & 8) – Mondays 7:00-8:15 PM

- Confirmation I (Grade 9) – Sundays 12:00 – 1:30 PM
- Confirmation II (Grade 10) – Sundays 12:00-1:30 PM

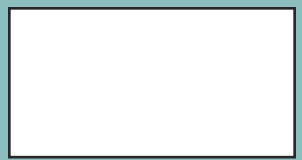

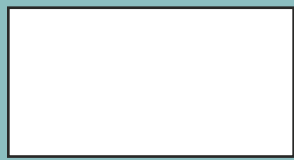
