However we don't need to be told to honor the Saints, as they are such a part of our lives as Catholics. There will be two Masses here at Saint Ann's on Monday: 7:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.*

*- PLEASE SAVE THE DATE: For the Ecumenical Celebration of Thanksgiving to be held this year at the First Congregational Church (the “Stone Church”) of Raynham. I had a great meeting with Reverend Tilbe last week. He is great friend of Saint Ann's Parish... and a wonderful Gentleman! 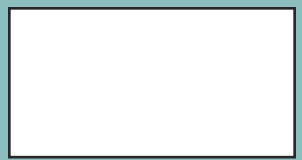

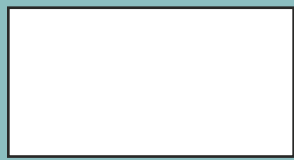
