SYNOD

OVERVIEW

Over the next several years, the Church around the world will be participating in a process called the Synod on Synodality. The Holy Father will be meeting with Bishops from across the globe in 2023 to discuss ways of improving the process by which the church communicates on all levels, and is open to hearing the voices of people from all walks of life.

Long term goal to rebuild the local church in decision making processes through communion, participation, and mission.
