

Dear Friends.

When a young person in their teens or early 20s receives a personal letter from the Bishop, it's a nice surprise. You don't forget that. One such teen confided in me that he kept this letter in his school backpack, and reread it nearly every day for a year. It was a personal invitation to attend an annual Vocation Discernment Retreat. At the end of that year, he was ready to attend the retreat. He did, and now years later he's on the threshold of priestly ordination.

Let's ask Bishop McManus to send personal invitation letters to a good number of our own young people at St. John's over the next few months. I need your help to make that happen. I'd like your recommendations.

Every year Bishop McManus hosts a Priesthood Discernment Retreat for young men, high school age, college age, and in the working-world. This year's retreat is scheduled on Friday, April 9 & Saturday, April 10. The retreat site is the Immaculate Conception Retreat Center in Putnam Connecticut – only 30 minutes south of Worcester, just over the MA/CT border.


The retreat begins at 6pm on Friday evening, and ends at 6pm on Saturday evening. Traditionally, 30 to 40 men attend this retreat. Time for presentations, prayer, confession, Masses, devotions, and recreation are scheduled. The sooner these men receive an invitation, the more time they will have to reflect upon their God-given vocations and clear their schedules should they choose to attend. This will also provide some time to organize carpooling for our St. John's group of men to and from Putnam, CT. It would be really great to have 10 or more young men attend.

Please email, text, or hand me the names and addresses of any young men in our parish who you believe may have a possible vocation to the priesthood. I'll make sure that they receive a personal invitation from Bishop McManus to attend this retreat on April 9 & 10. Thank you for your help.


