## St. John, Guardian of Our Lady

Dear Friends.

On Tuesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>, we'll celebrate the Feast Day of the Conversion of Saint Paul, Apostle.

In the first Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we read the words, "On that journey as I drew near to Damascus, about noon a great light from the sky suddenly shone around me. I fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?' I replied, 'Who are you, sir?' And he said to me, 'I am Jesus the Nazorean whom you are persecuting."

This moment is so moving. Just as the Father has spoken from heaven in the Old and New Testaments, now Jesus, resurrected and ascended, speaks from heaven. St. Paul's conversation begins with a question, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" The verb is present-tense— "persecuting." We may ask, "How is Paul possibly persecuting the resurrected and ascended Jesus?"


Of course, this is answered in Matthew's Gospel so profoundly when Jesus says, "'Amen, I say to you, whatever **you did** for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me," and "'Amen, I say to you, what you **did not do** for one of these least ones, you did not do for me."

In these words from the Gospel, Jesus informs us that our kindness towards others and our neglect towards others is experienced by Jesus as well. In the same manner, we can understand how Our Lord's use of the present tense – "persecuting" – is so perfectly

communicated to St. Paul in the question, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"

Whenever we fall into the darkness of selfishness, apathy, or sloth, may this profound moment from St. Paul's conversion sober us quickly to the truth of our constant personal interactions, day to day with the Lord, through our brothers and sisters.


