

THE Fourth Sunday of Lent

March 27, 2022

"Your brother was dead and has come to life again."

Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32

Dear Parishioners:

Today's gospel is well known for the value it places on welcoming those who have turned away. "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." However, it is worth looking at where Jesus stands when he shares this parable: in the midst of tax collectors and sinners. Jesus isn't preaching to faithful Jews; he preaching to a group of people whom the faithful Jews want nothing to do with. By physically aligning himself with sinners, Jesus delivers his message in a way that the Pharisees find threatening. They are used to avoiding sinners and keeping themselves "clean" by staying away from those who threaten their holiness. Jesus does not espouse this mindset. He goes into a crowd of sinners and shares a story of a sinner being accepted.

How do you think the father in this parable felt during the time that his son was away? Do you think the father turned all of his attention to the second, faithful son? Do you think the father thought and prayed about his far-off son? "While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion." His father saw him coming before he had arrived. Perhaps the father was even waiting. Perhaps he had been waiting a long time. Jesus does not stand in a crowd of faithful to welcome home sinners. He goes to the sinners, seeing them even though they are a long way off.

This week we celebrate the second scrutiny at the 10:00 am Mass with Sarah and Andy who will be baptized, confirmed and receive Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. The readings (Cycle A) focus on 'light.' We hear of the man born blind, one who has lived in darkness his whole life. In St. Paul tells us in his letter to the Ephesians:

Brothers and sisters:
You were once darkness,
but now you are light in the Lord.
Live as children of light,
for light produces every kind of goodness
and righteousness and truth.

As we pray for Sarah and Andy to be children of the light, may we also pray for ourselves to be more light than darkness, be people of hope and peace.

Thank you for your generosity to the collection for Ukraine. The amount of \$4,615.00 which includes \$330 from the soup supper has been sent to the Diocese and will be forwarded.

Today is the Bay Ridge St. Patrick Day Parade. The Parish Family of St. Ephrem will be marching together. I hope you can join us either marching with us or cheering us on along the parade route. We will gather at 12 Noon at 3rd Avenue and Marine Avenue. I look forward to seeing today.



The Story of the Pretzel


