

#### FROM BISHOP TOBIN: "It is time to return to Mass"

Bishop Tobin has signed a formal decree restoring the obligation to attend Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Providence.

This means that Catholics, in observance of the Lord's Day and in fulfillment of the law of the Church, are once again **obliged to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation**, unless they are otherwise dispensed for some serious reason.

The lifting of the Sunday Mass dispensation marks an important moment in our return to more normal, typical pastoral life. It is important to emphasis that, some individuals are not obliged to attend Sunday Mass, and perhaps should not attend Mass to protect their health and safety, and that of others. These include those who are elderly and frail, those who have underlying health conditions, and those who have been advised by their health care providers to avoid public gatherings. And as always, Catholics are dispensed from Sunday obligation for other grave reasons such as illness, caring for the ill, the unavoidable obligations of their employment, and travel that disrupts their schedules.

"O God, bring me to your holy mountain, to the place of your dwelling, that I may come to the altar of God, to God, my joy, my delight." (Ps 43: 3-4)

#### **NEW DIRECTIVES FROM THE DIOCESE:**

Fully vaccinated parishioners are **NO LONGER** required to wear a facemask indoors and outdoors. Indoor seating capacity is increased to 100%.

Those who are not fully vaccinated should continue to wear a facemask indoors. Social gatherings at the church may resume with 100% seating capacity. Parishioners should continue to use hand sanitizer upon entry to the church.

The distribution of the Precious Blood at Holy Communion will still remain suspended. The church will continue proper ventilation for increased airflow.


## THE FOOD COLLECTION IS BACK!
