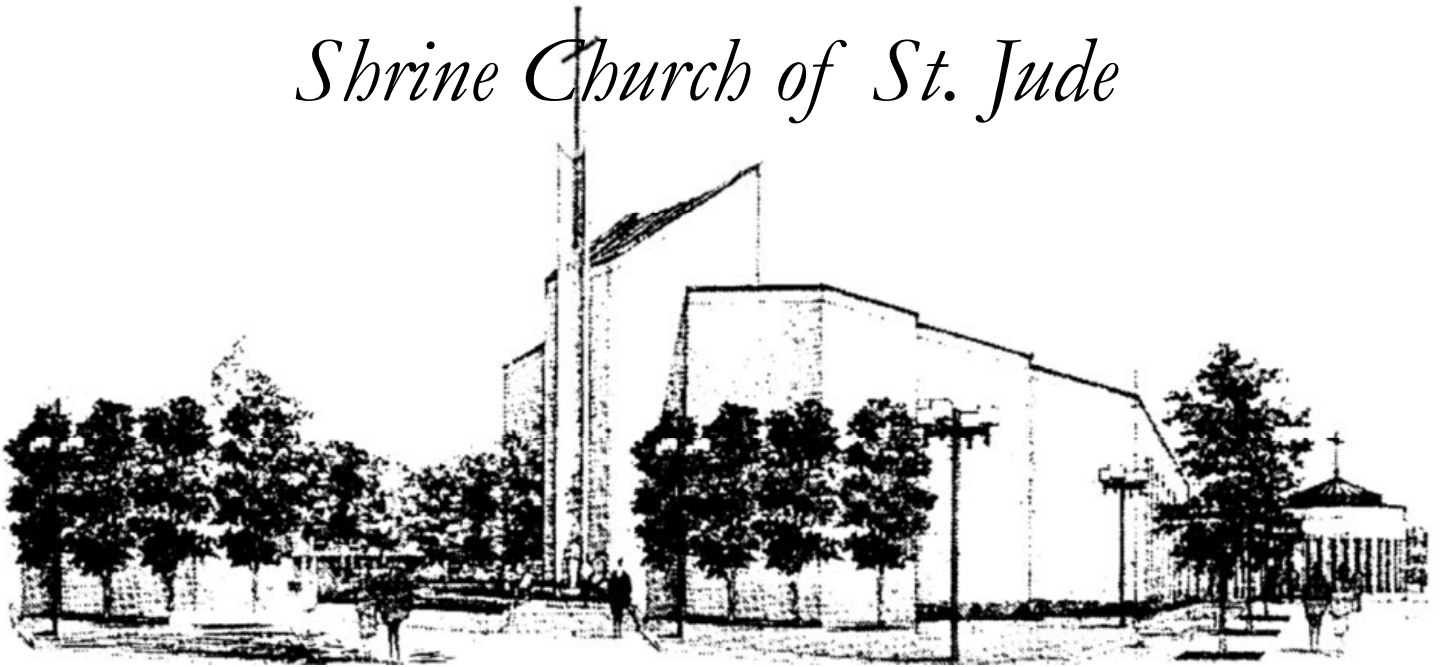

PARISH REGISTRATION

* ARE YOU RECEIVING CHURCH ENVELOPES?

* ARE YOU REGISTERED AND NOT RECEIVING THE ENVELOPES?
