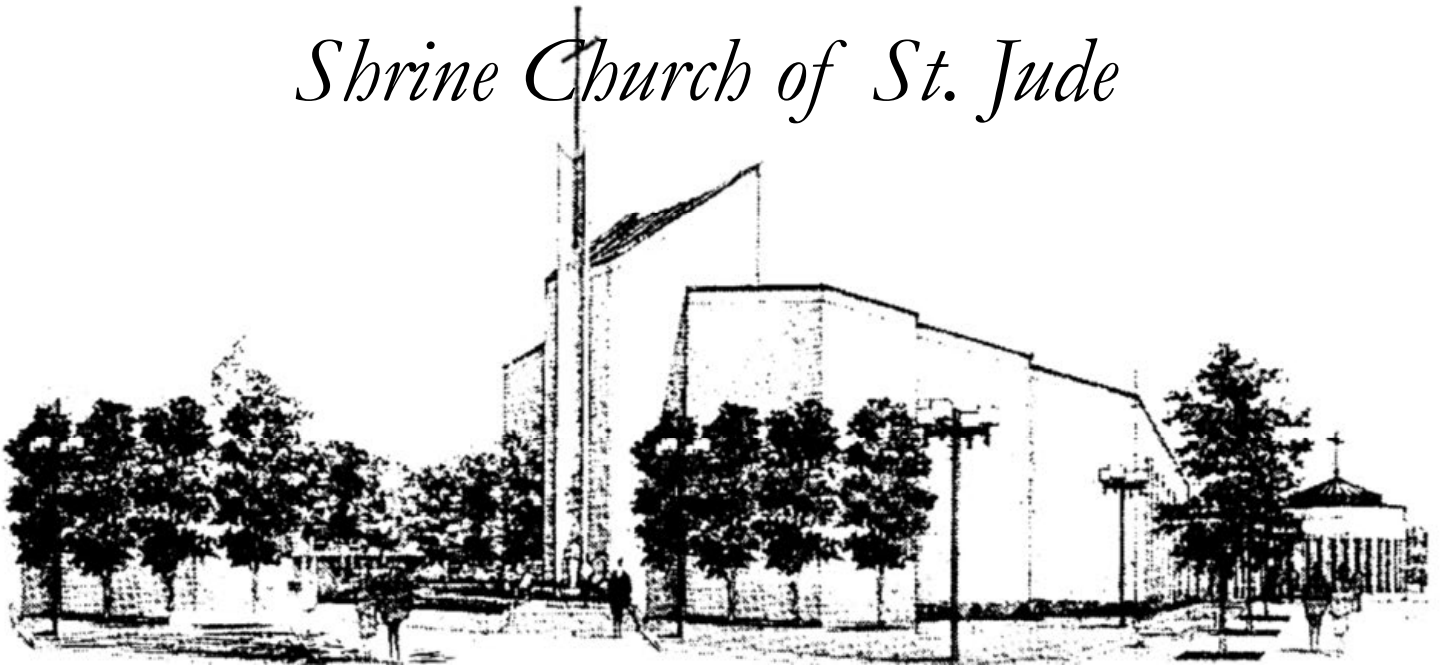

We welcome all people seeking communion with us. We respond to Christ's command to teach all people through instruction in the Catholic Faith in our religious education programs and Catholic School.

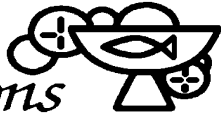

PARISH REGISTRATION

* ARE YOU RECEIVING CHURCH ENVELOPES?

* ARE YOU REGISTERED AND NOT RECEIVING THE ENVELOPES?

You must be registered in the parish to receive envelopes. You must be using the envelopes in order to get tax statements and to show the school you are attending mass.
