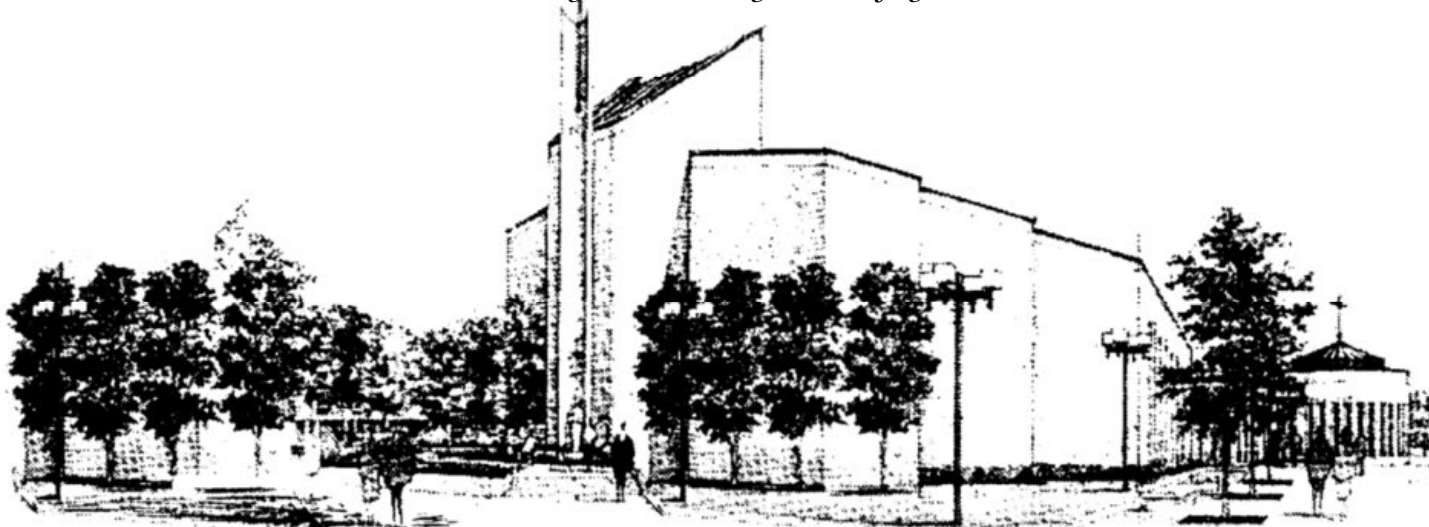

- * Are you receiving church envelopes?

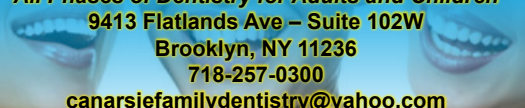
