A COLUNA DE PADRE JEFF



Neste **Terceiro Domingo do Tempo Comum**, a Igreja celebra o **Domingo da Palavra de Deus**, um dia feito para ajudar os católicos a refocar e reencontrar a importância da Escritura em suas vidas.

Em Romanos 8:26, São Paulo escreve: *“Não sabemos que pedir nas nossas orações.”* Estas notícias,

enquanto parte da revelação graciosa de Deus, são apenas arrasadoras. Confirma algo que a maioria de nós já intui: a nossa vida de oração não é como deveria ser. Somos facilmente distraídos, egoístas em nossos desejos, impuros em nossas intenções. Mesmo os Apóstolos reconheceram esses problemas em si mesmos. Daí sua petição em Lucas 11:1: *“Senhor, ensina-nos a orar.”* Em resposta ao seu pedido, Jesus ensina a eles, e por extensão a todos nós, o que conhecemos como o *“Pai Nosso.”*

Nessa oração, Jesus identifica *“o pão nosso de cada dia nos dai hoje”* como uma das petições que devemos dirigir ao Pai. Há muitos significados embalados nesta única petição, sendo o mais óbvio (pelo menos para católicos) uma alusão à Eucaristia (*Catecismo da Igreja Católica*, 2836). Mas há outro tipo de *“pão de cada dia,”* ao qual Jesus se refere quando Satanás O tenta no deserto. Ali, Jesus, conforme escrito em Mateus 4:4, repreende o convite de Satanás para transformar as pedras em pães, citando Deuteronômio 8:3: *“Nem só de pão vive o homem, mas...de toda a palavra que sai da boca de Deus.”*

A Eucaristia é essencial para o florescimento humano. Mas, como Jesus deixa claro nessa passagem, a Palavra de Deus é igualmente essencial para nossa existência e vida. Se queremos orar como devemos, precisamos meditar e *“mastigar”* diariamente.

Vamos todos tomar o tempo para meditar na Palavra de Deus diariamente. Como diz o refrão do Salmo de hoje: *“As vossas palavras, Senhor, são espírito e vida.”*

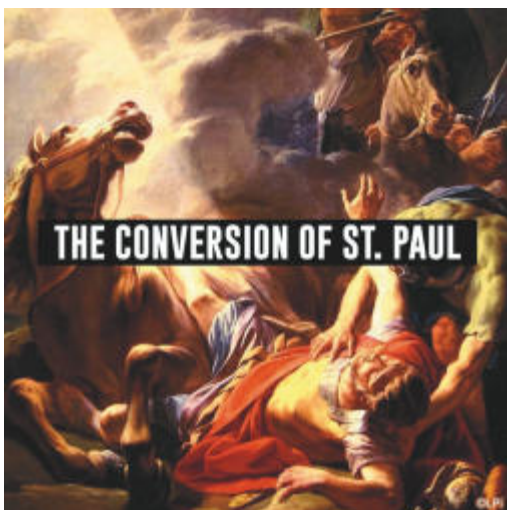

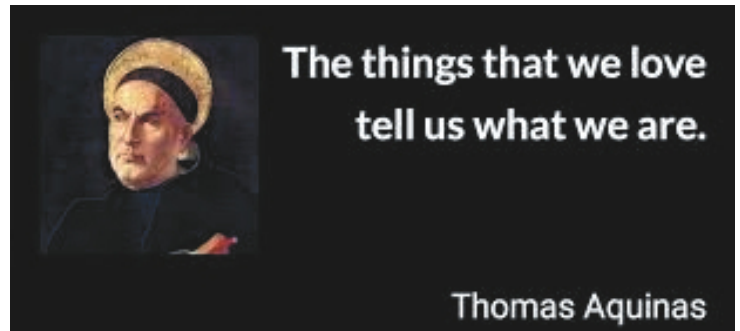

FR. JEFF'S COLUMN



This **Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**, the Church celebrates the **Sunday of the Word of God**, a day meant to help Catholics refocus and reencounter the importance of Scripture in their lives.

In Romans 8:26, St. Paul tells us: *“We do not know how to pray as we ought.”* The news, while part of God’s gracious revelation, is hardly earth shattering. It confirms something most of us already intuit: our prayer life isn’t as it should be. We are easily distracted, selfish in our desires, impure in our intentions. Even the Apostles recognized these problems in themselves. Hence their petition in Luke 11:1, *“Lord, teach us to pray.”* In answer to their request, Jesus teaches them, and by extension all of us, what we know as the *“Our Father.”*

In that prayer, Jesus identifies *“give us this day our daily bread”* as one of the petitions we should address to the Father. There are many meanings packed into this single petition, the most obvious of which (at least for Catholics) is an allusion to the Eucharist (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 2836). But there is another kind of *“daily bread,”* which Jesus references when Satan tempts Him in the desert. There, Jesus, as recorded in Matthew 4:4, rebukes Satan’s invitation to turn the rocks into bread by quoting Deuteronomy 8:3: *“Man does not live by bread alone, but ... by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.”*

The Eucharist is essential to human flourishing. But, as Jesus makes clear in that passage, the Word of God is just as essential to our existence and life. If we want to pray *“as we ought,”* we need to meditate and *“chew”* on it daily.

Let us all take the time to meditate on the Word of God daily. As today’s Psalm refrain states: *“Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life.”*

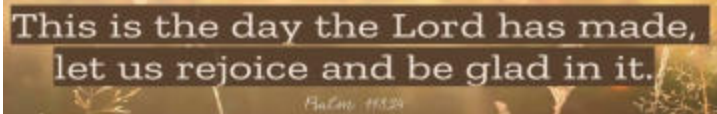
