

I would like to extend a special word of gratitude to our Religious Education Director Ms. Paula Dolliver for preparing them so well, especially in light of dealing with the pandemic.



Archdiocese has indicated that we will need to keep windows open for ventilation during Mass.

Thank you to all who have volunteered to help sanitize and usher during this difficult time. With your faithfull assistance things have gone very smoothly.

I would also like to express a word of gratitude to those who have been so faithful in supporting St. George Parish during this critical time. As you might imagine, the offertory collection, which we depend upon to meet our expenses, has dropped dramatically this year. As you know parishes depend upon the support of their parishioners. I am mindful of these difficult economic times but I would ask you to be generous in supporting your parish as your circumstances permit.

I understand that many (particularly those in a vulnerable situation) may not feel comfortable joining us at this time. Cardinal Sean has continued the dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation so feel free to remain at home.

CONFESSIONS

Confessions are heard on Saturdays at 3:15pm. Please enter by the door for the chapel (lift entrance) - door B on the lower level. Stand in front of the clear plastic curtain. If someone is ahead of you, please wait outside the door.

- 1. As of May 29, 2021 vaccinated people are no longer required to wear masks or socially distance at Mass.
- 2. Vaccinated people may, of course, continue to wear masks and socially distance.
- 3. The state does advise that non-vaccinated people continue to wear masks.
- 4. Each parishioner/family will be expected to make a reasonable decision about when they are ready to take off their masks and be near other people.
- 5. Areas of the Church will be designated for social distancing for those who desire that option. In the non socially distanced area(s) all pews can be used.
- 6. We are permitted to use misalettes once again.
- 7. The dispensation from the obligation for coming to Sunday Mass has been lifted, however, if a parishioner is feeling ill they should remain at home.
- 8. Congregational singing may resume.
- 9. Sanitizing is no longer required after every liturgy.


